## 3. WHAT is the OBJECTIVE of ASFA?

**Article-1** of the **ASFA Partnership Agreement** describes the overall **objective** of the ASFA co-operation (<a href="http://www.fao.org/fi/asfa/agreemt.asp">http://www.fao.org/fi/asfa/agreemt.asp</a>)

"The overall objective of ASFA co-operation is to develop and maintain a service for the collection and dissemination of information on the science, technology and management of marine, brackish water and fresh water environments, organisms and resources, including economic, sociological and legal aspects, in a form easily accessible to the user community, bearing in mind the special interests of developing countries\* and based on the pooling of literature monitoring and indexing activities by the individual partners, consistent with internationally accepted standards and practices. The service shall include a computer searchable bibliographic database, associated printed abstracts journals and the relevant tools for the control of the system and aids to its use.."

\*(by "special interests of developing countries" we include the full participation in international schemes under the aegis of the UN system for the collection, analysis and use of data and information; equitable and affordable access to relevant information services and products; and the strengthening of national capacities in information handling and communication).
