

# **INTERNATIONAL SYMPOSIUM --EUCALYPTS IN ASIA**

Zhanjiang, China 8 – 11 April 2003

Post-symposium technical tour 12 – 16 April 2003

## ***First Announcement***

The China Eucalypt Research Centre, Forest Science Centre, Victoria and the Australian Centre for International Agricultural Research (ACIAR) are jointly organizing a symposium in 2003 to present the results of recent research from several countries related to the establishment and management of *Eucalyptus* plantations in Asia.

The symposium will bring together researchers and practitioners to discuss the latest practices, knowledge and research on genetics, silviculture, resource management and environmental issues relating to eucalypt plantations and their sustainability.

This is the first announcement and invitation. Please pass on this information to your colleagues and associates with an interest in eucalypt plantations.

### **Location**

The symposium will be held in Zhanjiang – a delightful harbour city and one of China's original "open cities". It is also a focus for China's expanding resource of commercial eucalypt plantations and associated industries. China now has in excess of 800,000 ha of eucalypt plantations and an even larger area of '4-around' plantings - around the houses, villages, roads and canals.

### **Travel**

Zhanjiang is about a 1-hour flight from Guangzhou International Airport with several direct services daily. There are also numerous train and express bus services each day between the two cities. Guangzhou is serviced by China Southern, Air China, Thai, Singapore and many other international airlines.

### **Symposium Venue**

The symposium will be held at the Haibin Hotel in Zhanjiang – a harbour-side four-star hotel with a garden setting. It offers a number of accommodation options ranging in price from US\$30 to US\$80 per day. Other good hotels nearby are available from around US\$20. Full details on accommodation options will be provided with the Second Announcement.

### **Field Tours**

The symposium will include a full day field tour to Leizhou Peninsula and will provide the opportunity to observe aspects of the well developed tropical eucalypt plantation industry including a major high technology propagation center, field trials, clonal plantations and wood processing plants. An optional post-symposium technical tour will also be offered to travel further afield, visiting a wider range of eucalypt plantations, research centers, associated industries and famous scenic spots in southern China.

## **Language**

Poster and oral presentations and Symposium proceedings will be in English.

## **Submission of Abstracts**

Intending participants are invited to submit abstracts of papers and/or posters for presentation at the Symposium. Acceptance of presentations will be based on short abstracts or summaries of up to one A4 page. These must be submitted via post, fax or email received by December 15<sup>th</sup> 2002.

Please provide the following information in English:

- Title
- Whether paper is to be considered as a poster or oral presentation.
- Authors, presenting author first
- Affiliations of authors
- Abstract (should include brief summaries of methods, results and conclusions)

Acceptance or rejection of submitted abstracts will be advised by January 10<sup>th</sup> 2003. Full papers must be submitted by 15<sup>th</sup> March 2003.

## **Proceedings**

Following the Symposium, the proceedings will be edited for publication by the Australian Centre for International Agricultural Research as a collection of research papers within the ACIAR Proceedings series.
