FOREST RESEARCH AND AFFORESTATION IN KORQIN SANDY LANDS A CASE STUDY: THE BELGIUM-CHINA-FAO PROJECT GCP/CPR/009/BEL

Background

The Project GCP/CPR/009/BEL: Afforestation, Forestry Planning and Research in the Three North Region of China has been implemented since 1990 by the Chinese Government, with Technical Assistance from FAO and co-financing from the Government of Belgium in the Korqin Sandy Lands of North East China (Eastern part of Inner Mongolia Autonomous Region, bordering with Liaoning and Jilin Provinces).

The second phase of the project (1998-2002) is now coming to an end. A series of results have been achieved on topics such as site classification, clonal selection, genetic conservation, tree breeding, mechanised afforestation, nursery techniques, integrated land-use, sand dune stabilisation and re-vegetation. These results have practical applications in Korqin and may be relevant to the forestry, environmental and anti-desertification efforts on-going in northern China.

Objectives

The main objective of this Conference is to inform the forestry community, policy and decision makers, political authorities and public and private investors in Northern China of the results and achievements of 13 years of work of the Project and their potential.

A secondary objective is to highlight the investment opportunities in forestry that the region offers, and that have been identified by the Project.
