Recent developments from the Global Terrestrial Observing System, 26 June 2001

1) The NEW GTOS web page

The look and functionality of the GTOS webpage (www.fao.org/gtos) has been completely revised and updated. The site now includes an internal search engine to allow users to quickly locate information. Sub-pages of the site can be accessed rapidly through a horizontal "popup" navigation bar. Other features include a site directory with hot links and on line newsnote subscription and feedback forms. The improvement to the website was in conjunction with the release of the new version of TEMS (see news note 3 <http://www.fao.org/gtos/newsnote/newsnote2.pdf>).
