THEME AND OUTCOME

Enhancing organizational, technical and scientific leadership skills to address global nutritional challenges is an essential, but daunting, task. This is recognized by the United Nations University and a number of other International, Bilateral and Non-Governmental Agencies and relevant International Scientific Unions. While all of these agencies and organizations unequivocally recognize the importance of leadership and institutional capacity, their combined efforts are relatively in a low key compared with the magnitude of the need.

The United Nations University and the International Union of Nutritional Sciences, working closely with the International Nutrition Foundation are in the forefront of regional efforts for strengthening nutrition leadership capacity. Initial meetings held in this direction have laid stress on the point that there should be an adequate investment in human leadership and institutional capacity for nutrition-based development goals. The success of leadership and technical capacity development efforts by the stakeholders in these efforts is more dependent on cooperation, coordination and harmonization of implementation efforts. There is a growing recognition among institutions engaged in capacity development in many countries that the present training modules are inadequate for the needs of the target groups.

In view of the continuing need to develop future nutrition leaders with multidisciplinary skills in technical, management, policy analysis and advocacy, Central Food Technological Research Institute (CFTRI), Mysore, India in association with the International Nutrition Foundation, Tufts University and the United Nations University is organizing an International Symposium on 'Building Leadership Skills in Food and Nutrition for National Development' at Central Food Technological Research institute, Mysore, India, in June 2006. This symposium will identify needs for training in several areas of food and nutrition and deliberate on the current efforts being undertaken in different countries towards capacity building 'Agriculture, Food and Nutrition'.
