- **Strengthening forest policies and institutional capacities**
 - Analysis of institutional development in Central Asia and Caucasus – on going – workshop in Antalia (June)
- **National forest program**
 - Promoting financial strategies
 - Assist countries in collecting updated PLI information
 - Forest law compliance – FLEG processes
- **Enhance forest policies for poverty alleviation**
 - Methodologies for small scale forest enterprises
 - Effect of forest tenure on participatory forestry (Central Asia)

Multi-donors Trust Fund hosted by FAO aiming at assisting about 70 countries to develop and implement national forest programmes and focusing on:

- local needs and national priorities
- reflect internationally agreed principles
- informed participation of stakeholders
