1. Lack of wildlife management policy
2. Weak infrastructure for hunting
3. Old regulatory framework

Socio-economic problems

(e.g. lack of local community awareness regarding their rights, legislation, regulations, private sector lacking incentives to invest, restricted access to hunting (economical and administrative reasons), etc.)

1. Lack of involving the private sector for development of hunting
2. Illegal hunting
3. Weak community awareness regarding the importance of wildlife

Inter-sectoral management

(e.g. weak technical and human capacities, lack of specialists, conflicts of interests (between hunting, forestry and agricultural sector), competition between domestic animals and game, habitat degradation / Overexploitation etc.)

1. Weak of technical capacities
2. Professional specialists (lack of education establishment on professional hunting)
3. Weak capacity building of wildlife specialists
