All articles are subject to peer review. Articles between 4000-5000 words are preferred. They may be submitted on CDs or Floppy diskette (along with a hard copy) and/or can be sent by e-mail: infocom@cirdap.org.

Transcripts should be submitted in duplicate on A4 size paper, type written on one side in double space, with margins of at least 2.00cm. Statistical tables, illustrations and charts should be submitted on separate sheet and their positions indicated in the text. APJORD follows the Chicago Manual of Style for preparing article.
