Invitation to the Third Session of the Governing Body International Treaty on Plant Genetic Resources for Food and Agriculture

Tunis, Tunisia, 1 – 5 June 2009

Reply requested by 15 April 2009

The Director-General of the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations has the honour to extend an invitation to attend the Third Session of the Governing Body of the International Treaty on Plant Genetic Resources for Food and Agriculture. The Session will be held in Tunis (Tunisia) from 1 to 5 June 2009 and will be preceded by two days of consultations, on 30 and 31 May 2009. The opening session will begin at 10.00 a.m. on Monday, 1 June 2009.

The Governing Body is convened under the provisions of Article 19 of the Treaty and is open to all Contracting Parties to the International Treaty and to observers. Expenses incurred by representatives of Contracting Parties, when attending sessions of the Governing Body, or subsidiary bodies, as well as the expenses incurred by observers at sessions, shall be borne by their respective governments or organizations. However, extra-budgetary funds have been made available to the Secretariat, for the purpose of supporting one representative of developing country Contracting Parties, if requested. Countries wishing to avail themselves of such support should inform the Secretariat before 15 April 2009, and provide the name and full contact details of the representative.

The session will be conducted in Arabic, Chinese, English, French, Russian and Spanish.
