NOTIFICATION Capacity Building Workshop on Access and Benefit-sharing

Dear Madam/Sir,

Subsequent to the conclusion of a Memorandum of Cooperation between the Secretariats of the Convention on Biological Diversity (CBD) and the International Treaty to further enhance collaboration in areas of mutual interest within their mandates, the Governing Body, at its Fourth Session, requested me to explore practical means and activities to give effect to such cooperation, in particular through capacity building for access and benefit-sharing, as related to plant genetic resources for food and agriculture, including through the organization of workshops, seminars and other events.

I am pleased to inform you that a capacity building workshop on access and benefit-sharing will be held on **29-30 October 2011**, in Montreal, Canada, back to back with the seventh meeting of the *Ad Hoc* Open-ended Working Group on Article 8 (j) and Related Provisions (Working Group). The workshop is organized by the Secretariat of the CBD, in collaboration with the Secretariat of the International Treaty, and follows a first joint workshop that was held in June this year (the report of the first workshop is available at the following url: https://www.cbd.int/absicnp1/documents/).

In the context of the CBD's on-going work on traditional knowledge associated to genetic resources, and related capacity building needs and priorities, the workshop will provide an opportunity to share the experience of the International Treaty with respect to support and capacity-building provided to indigenous and local communities with the implementation of the International Treaty.
