

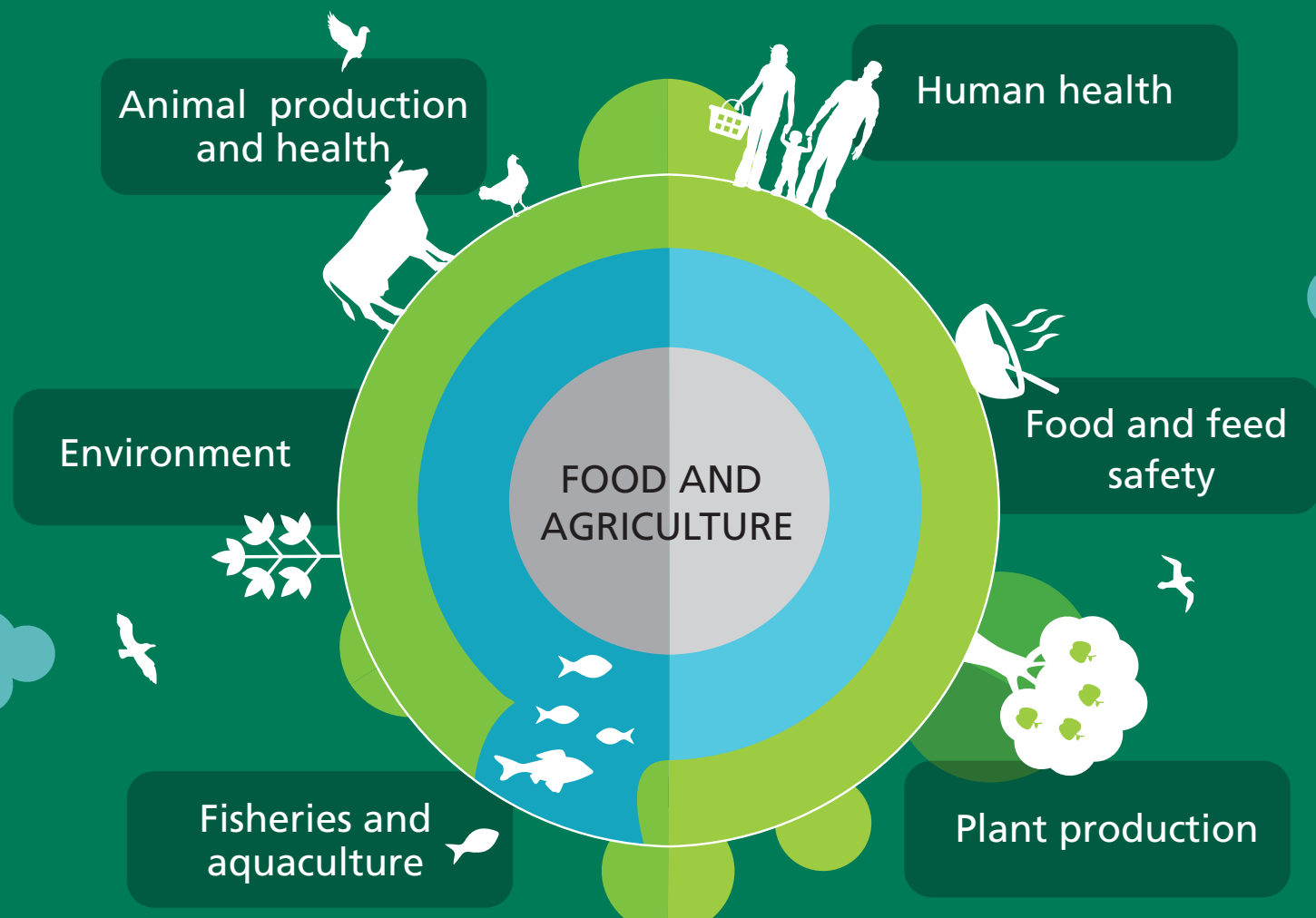

Antimicrobial resistance (AMR) is a multi-sectoral global threat



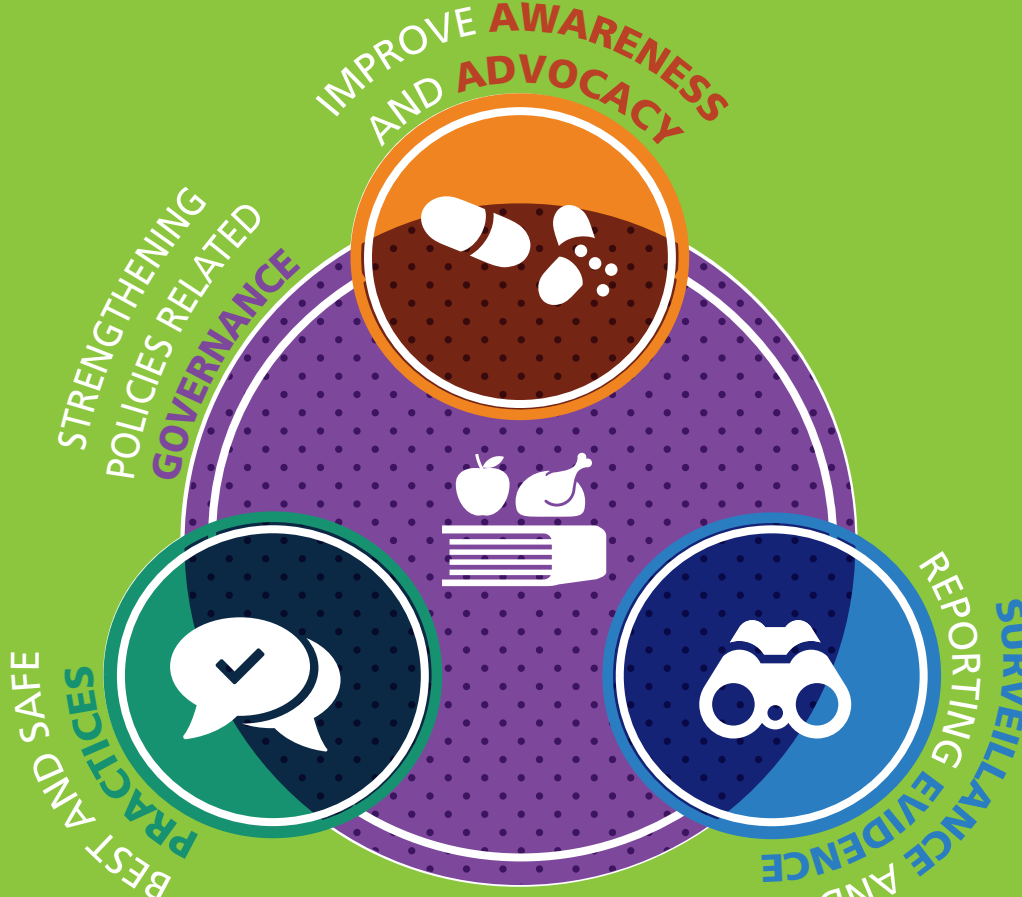
MULTI-SECTORAL APPROACH

FAO ACTION PLAN ON AMR

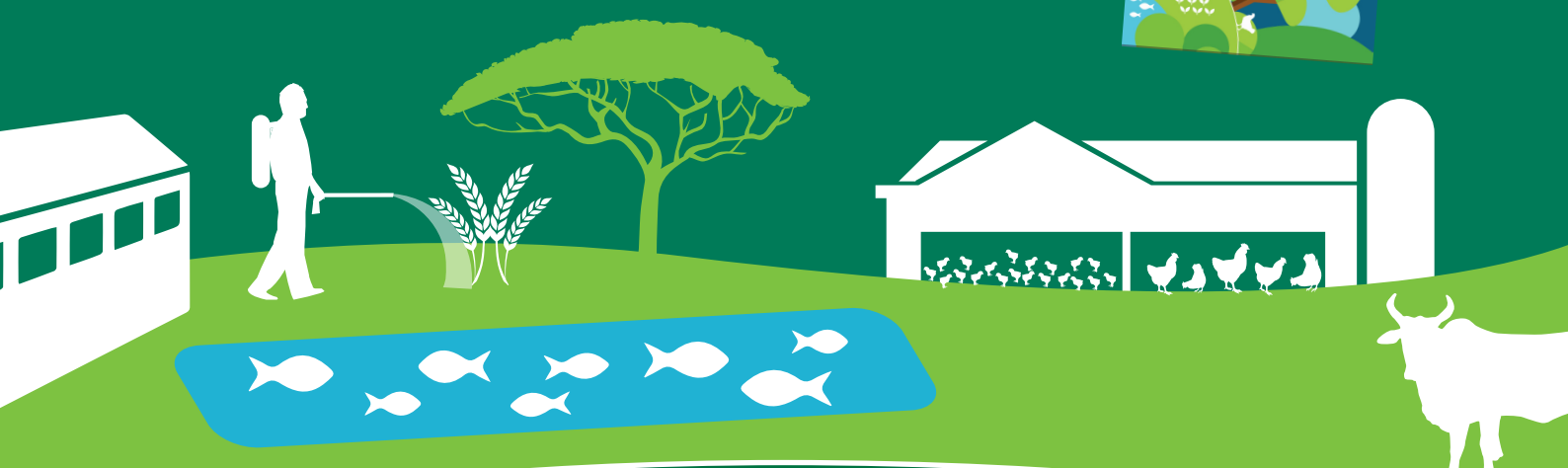


GLOBAL COMMITMENT TO LOCAL ACTION

FAO supports countries to develop a cross-sectoral national strategy, **NATIONAL ACTION PLAN ON ANTIMICROBIAL RESISTANCE**, to reduce the threat of antimicrobial resistance in **AGRICULTURE, LIVESTOCK, FISHERIES** and **FOOD PRODUCTION**.

This is done through regulating responsible use of antimicrobials (AMU) and the detection and prevention of acquired antimicrobial resistance (AMR).
