COFO23 SIDE EVENT

Towards a Regional Strategy and an Action Plan for Forest and Landscape Restoration in the Asia-Pacific region

BACKGROUND

During the Asia-Pacific Forestry Week 2016 (APFW) held in the Philippines, a high level consultation was organized on regional initiatives for Forest and Landscape Restoration (FLR) in order to initiate a discussion on the preparation of a regional action plan. Most country representatives recognized the importance of FLR issues and proposed to continue the dialogue on this regional action plan during the 23rd session of the Committee on Forestry (COFO).

An agenda item on FLR was discussed at the 26th session of the Asia-Pacific Forestry Commission (APFC) and member States proposed that FAO support the preparation of this regionally shared vision and action plan. Based on this recommendation, the FLR-Mechanism group and the FAO Regional Office for Asia and the Pacific prepared a draft strategy and an action plan for further discussion during COFO.

This side event will build on current regional dynamics of Forest and Landscape Restoration in the Asia-Pacific region and will provide an opportunity to present and discuss the draft strategy and action plan for FLR in order to move forward with coordinated action for forest restoration in the region.
