# Implementation

- Enhanced dialogue within the Country;
- Dialogue with UN agencies;
- Tiered approach;
- Opportunities for integration within the Environmental Accounting approach (SEEA Agriculture)\*
- Synergies of climate change actions and the SDGs process;

# Specific key messages for implementation of the SEEA Agriculture (1)

---

- 1) Resources: not requiring more but using better the existing ones;
- 2) Possibly information generated through this integrated framework may attract more resources;
- 3) By definition cross-cutting: implies strengthened integration and coordination among statistical agencies while implementing the system;

# Specific key messages for implementation of the SEEA Agriculture (2)

---

- 4) Allows using different Tiers based on interests (but some loss of cross-cutting and comparability should be then considered);
- 5) Contribution to compilation of implementation guidelines and improvement of data availability (e.g. fertilizers by crop);
- 6) Implementation has important feedbacks on the research agenda as specific themes and sectors are highlighted for further analyses (e.g. medicines, vaccines for animal health);
