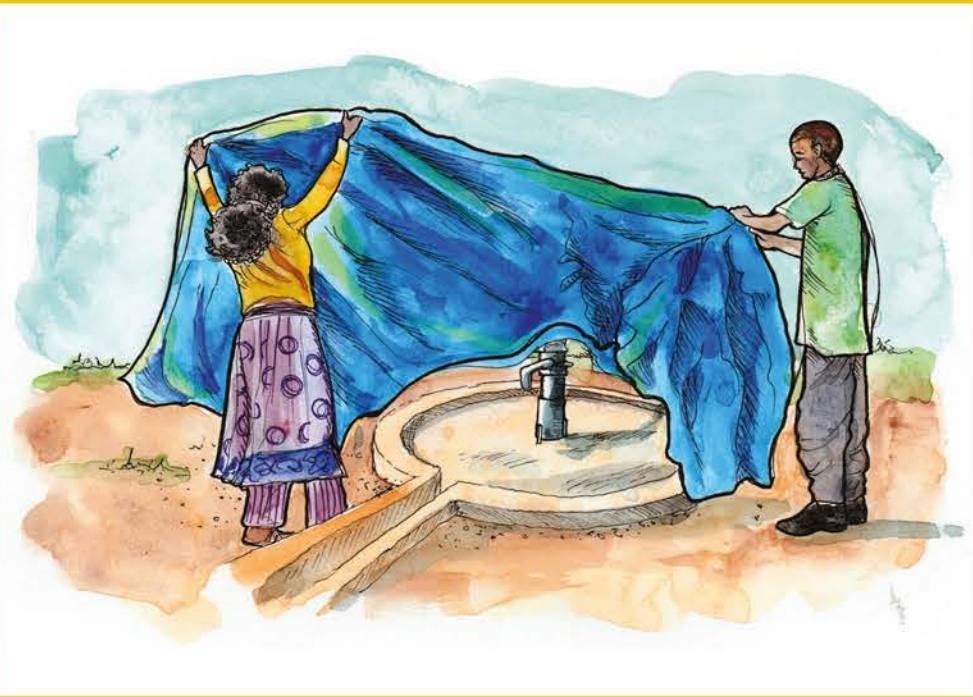
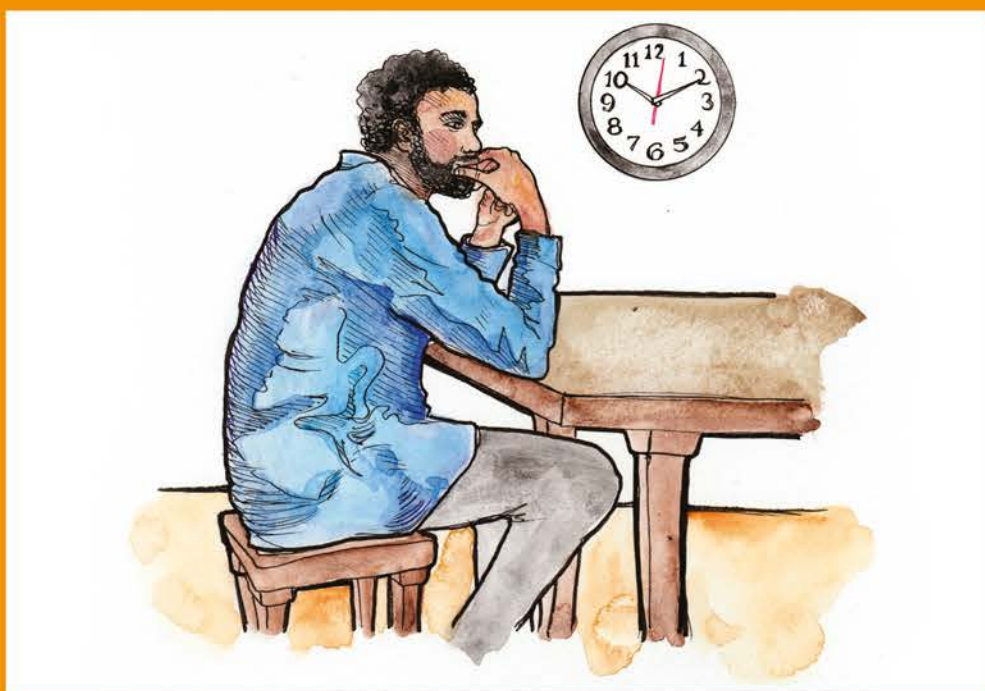


# SAFETY MEASURES DURING CONTROL OPERATIONS

If instructed by the survey or control team or the local authorities, cover wells or drinking water points.

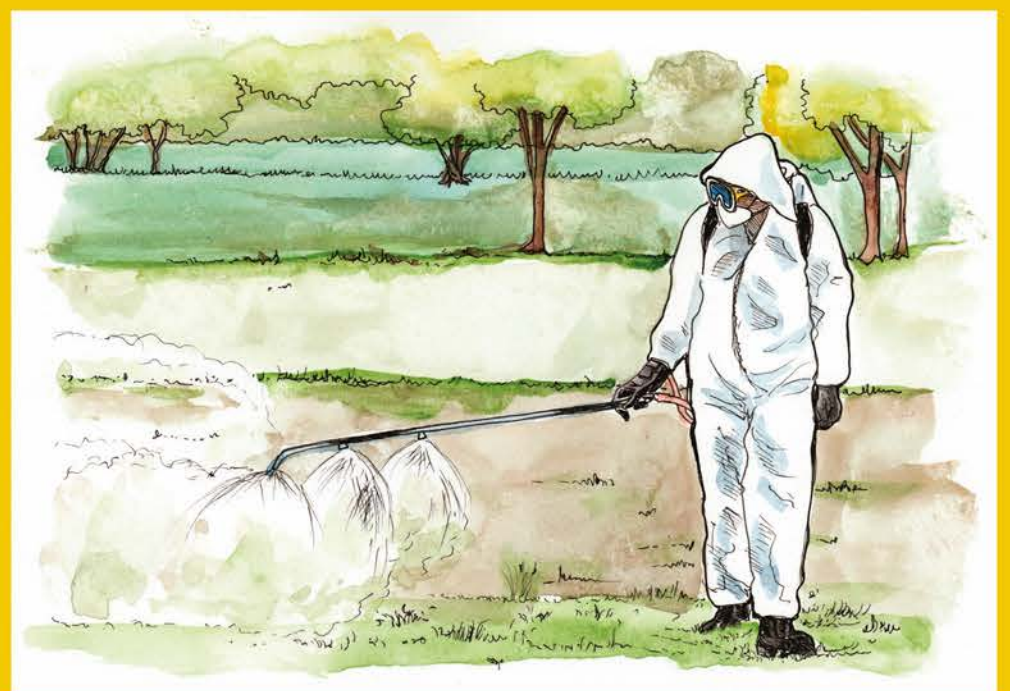


Remove **beehives** from fields to be treated, especially if plants are flowering. Generally, 3 to 5 km is a safe distance. Wait at least one week before returning honeybees to the treated fields.



Respect pre-harvest intervals and withholding periods – the minimum period of wait time between the pesticide application and access to the treated area.

**Wait at least 2 DAYS before you harvest the crops or let animals re-enter treated area.**
