Purpose

To present in brief form the data obtained, its implications and recommendations for future application of the indicator in the City County of Nairobi. For qualitative or descriptive indicators, describe the method, findings and evaluate the effectiveness of Nairobi's performance in relation to the MUFPP outcome areas and recommended actions. For quantitative indicators give the method, data sources and discuss the implications of the findings in relation to the MUFPP outcome areas and recommended actions.

Format

Background

For both qualitative and quantitative indicators give the source documents fully referenced. Give the policy context for the qualitative indicators and any recent historical events and activities that made it relevant to select the indicator and apply it for this pilot study.

Where relevant, include reference to how this choice of indicator can help other cities understand what is going on in Nairobi as a case study city. Also, where relevant, look forward to how this indicator can be useful to the City County of Nairobi over time, in building up a database and/or developing capacity for monitoring and evaluation. Methodology
