Background

Accelerating the **production and use of SDG indicators by national statistical systems** is one of FAO's key priorities as custodian agency of 21 SDG indicators. It is essential to:

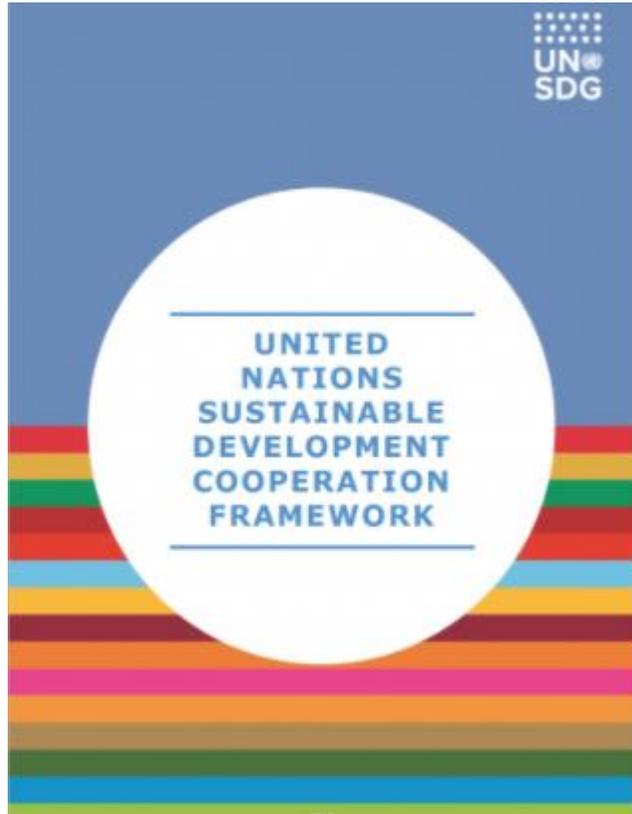
- Monitor **country's progress** and provide **actionable insights** on SDG and other global commitments;
- Improve **evidence-based decision-making** at national level;
- Monitor **UN system's performance**.

To achieve that, FAO has developed **regional roadmap** with two main objectives:

1. strengthen the **capacity of FAO decentralized and UN country teams** to mainstream statistics and SDG monitoring support in UN country-level programming
2. scale up **country-level technical assistance support**

We are presenting you today the **regional roadmap for Latin America and the Caribbean** for information and feedback

1) Strengthen statistical capacity of FAO decentralized offices and UN country teams



Objective: Ensure that statistics and the production of SDG indicators are seen as a development outcomes and fully integrated in UNSDCF and CPF

Activities:

- Training of FAO decentralized offices and UN Country teams on:
 - tools to mainstreaming statistics in CCA, UNSDCF and CPF
 - flagship statistical capacity development programme and SDG indicators (e.g. 50by2030, FIES, ...)
- Strengthen validation process of UNSDCF and CPF
- Support on project formulation and resources mobilization
- Support on the integration of SDG indicators in FAO/UN projects
- Leverage partnerships and improve coordination
- Improve accountability of decentralized offices

2) Scale up country-level technical assistance support (1/2)



Objective: Provide timely support to national statistical systems on the production and use of SDG indicators under FAO custodianship

Activities:

- Annual call of expression of interest
- Regional Project (TCP/RLA/3730) Improving agricultural censuses and surveys for producing SDG indicators
- Translation of all e-learning on SDG indicators in Spanish
- Systematically promote the production of SDG indicators as part of census engagement process
- Systematically promote the integration of FIES in national household surveys

2) Scale up country-level technical assistance support (2/2)



Activities (continued):

- Development and implementation of well-defined technical assistance activities/projects, including support on:
 - aligning national and global SDG monitoring framework;
 - mainstreaming SDG data needs in NSDS;
 - the production and reporting of the indicators;
 - the use of alternative data sources for the production of SDG data;
 - measuring SDG progress ;
 - data disaggregation techniques;
 - the integration of SDG indicators in analytical publications (e.g. VNR).
- Assistance in completing 50by2030 applications
- Support NSSs in resources mobilization
- Document and share best practices and lessons learned
