Africa

Africa is not on track to meet SDG 2. Recent estimates show that 281.6 million people on the continent – over one-fifth of the population – faced hunger in 2020, which is 46.3 million more than in 2019. Asia and the Pacific

An estimated 375.8 million people in Asia and the Pacific faced hunger in 2020, which is nearly 54 million more people than in 2019. Near East and North Africa

Arab States face significant challenges in achieving both SDG target 2.1 and SDG target 2.2. The deteriorating food security situation suggests that a greater number of people face difficulties in accessing a healthy diet, which will have negative implications for their nutritional status. Europe and Central Asia



Mid-term evaluation of the project "Forest and Farm Facility – Climate resilient landscapes and improved livelihoods" – Phase II

The Forest and Farm Facility (FFF) aims at supporting forest and farm producers and their organizations (FFPOs) to enable climate-resilient landscapes and improved livelihoods through the approval of small grants for producers' organizations, training and exchanges, and the documentation and dissemination of good practices.

Terminal evaluation of the project "Disposal of obsolete pesticides including persistent organic pesticides, promotion of alternatives and strengthening pesticides management in the Caribbean"

The project contributed to the collection and shipment of obsolete pesticides (319 tonnes) from all 11 project countries and polychlorinated biphenyls (54 tonnes) from four countries. However, it was unable to successfully replicate and build capacities with government stakeholders evenly across all countries in the Caribbean.

The European Commission for the Control of Foot-and-Mouth Disease Workplans – Phase V. Second biennium 2021–2023

The European Commission for the Control of Foot-and-Mouth Disease (EuFMD) has established an internationally respected capacity for efficient delivery of training and in-country support to Foot-and-Mouth Disease (FMD) Progressive Control Programmes, and, most recently, for the modelling of FMD control measures to guide emergency planning.
