Background

Accelerating the **production and use of SDG indicators by National Statistical Systems** is one of FAO's key priorities as custodian agency of 21 SDG indicators. It is essential to:

- Monitor **country's progress** and provide **actionable insights** on SDGs and other global and regional commitments; i.e. Regional SDG progress reports, Post-2020 Global Biodiversity framework;
- Improve **evidence-based decision-making** at national level;
- Monitor **UN Development System's performance**.

FAO has developed a ***Roadmap for SDG Monitoring in Asia-Pacific*** with two main objectives:

1. Strengthen the **capacity of FAO decentralized and UN country teams** to mainstream statistics and SDG monitoring support in UN country-level programming.
2. Scale-up **country-level technical collaboration**.

PRIORITY AREA 1

- Delivery of a **training programme targeting FAO DO + UNCT STAFF** in collaboration with UN development agencies
- **Communication plan** to keep FAO DO and UNCTs informed and engaged (including regular update of toolkit)
- Mechanism to **share best practices, new developments** and keep relevant staff engaged

- Support to SDG indicators through **SDG-specific Statistical Development programme** (SDGs, TCPs, VoH)
- **Promotion of FAO CD programmes** at APCAS and national level

PRIORITY AREA 3

Encourage and support COUNTRIES in collecting key SDG indicators in major WCA/AgSurvey/HHS Projects



- Systematically promote the production of SDG farm-based indicators as part of **census engagement process** and TCPs
- Ensure that the production of **SDG farm-based indicators are produced through the 50x2030** in targeted countries
- Systematically promote the production of SDG farm-based indicators and conduct **targeted outreach to non-50x2030 countries** that have agricultural surveys
- Systematically promote the **production of FIES data and SDG indicator 5.a.1** in national household surveys

Ensure that **statistics and SDG monitoring are sufficiently mainstreamed** in CCA, UNSDCF and CPFs through:

- The provision of **easy-to use country data profiles** to facilitate the CCA
- the provision of **supplementary guidance** on mainstreaming data and statistics in these document
- Improved **review process** before validation

PRIORITY AREA 5

Support NATIONAL-level resources mobilization for SDG monitoring



- Assist Decentralized Offices in **establishing country-level projects** and in supporting **resources mobilization** at national or regional level
- Identify and share best practices in terms of **integrating/aligning SDG indicators in national projects** (e.g. M&E, data collection, use in project design and decision-making, ...)

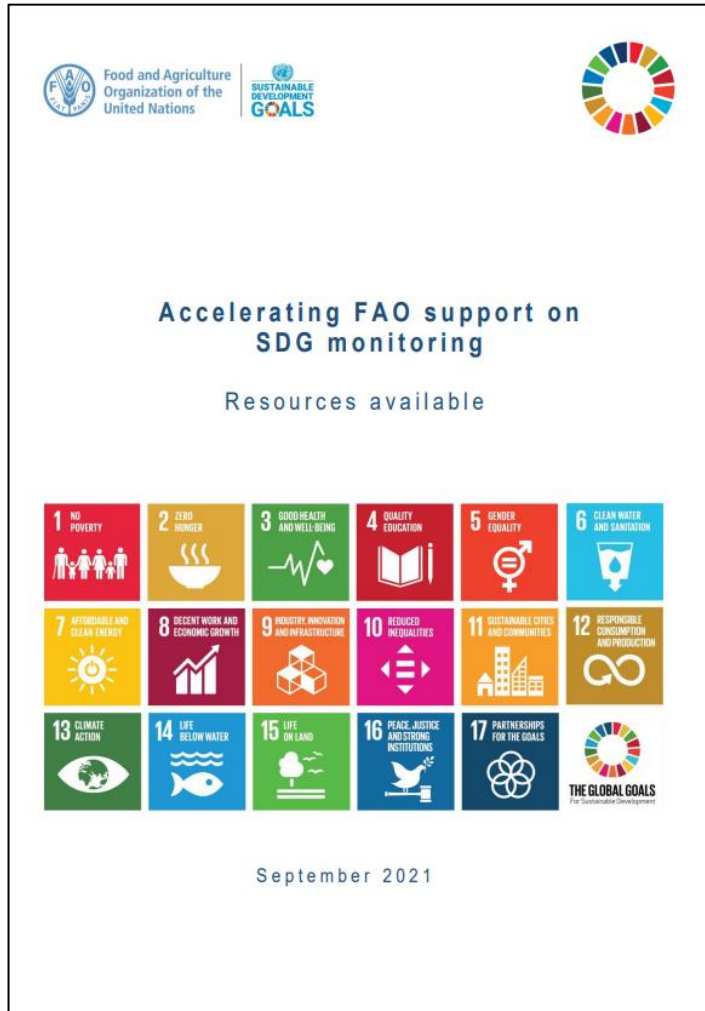
- **Coordination mechanisms** established for the implementation of the roadmap
