### Sharing the richness of FAO Library’s collections with FAO Goodwill Ambassadors and Representatives



This past month, the Library team was honoured to share the richness of the David Lubin Memorial Library collections with several high-profile visitors. The HRH Princess Basma bint Ali of Jordan (see picture in the Rare Books Room), HE Siti Nurbaya Bakar, Minister of Environment and Forestry of the Republic of Indonesia and Mr. Enrique Parada Rivas, Minister for Agriculture and Livestock of El Salvador. The Rare Books collection consists of 185 rare books (400 volumes) dating from the 15th to 18th century. This includes 20 incunables, books printed during the earliest period of publishing in Europe (before 1501).

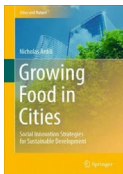
