

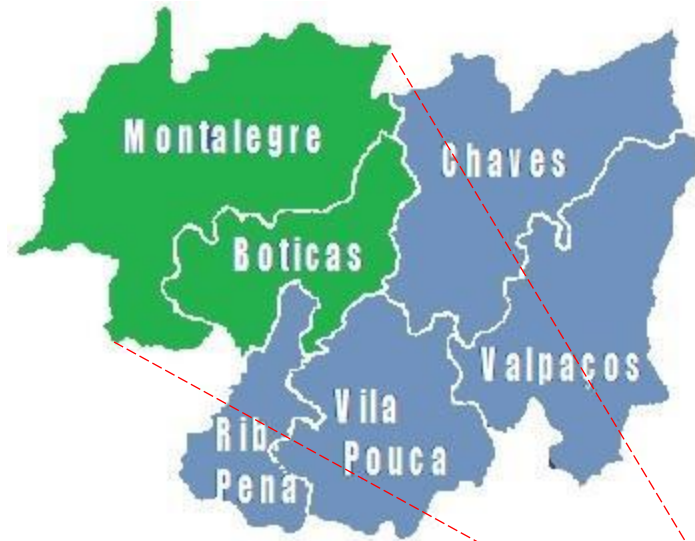

The Barroso area is located in North Portugal, Alto Tâmega's Region/NUTIII, with a surface of 1.127,40km² and a population of 14.281 inhabitants ($\approx 12,66$ inhabit./km²).



A system combining agriculture, pastoralism and forestry

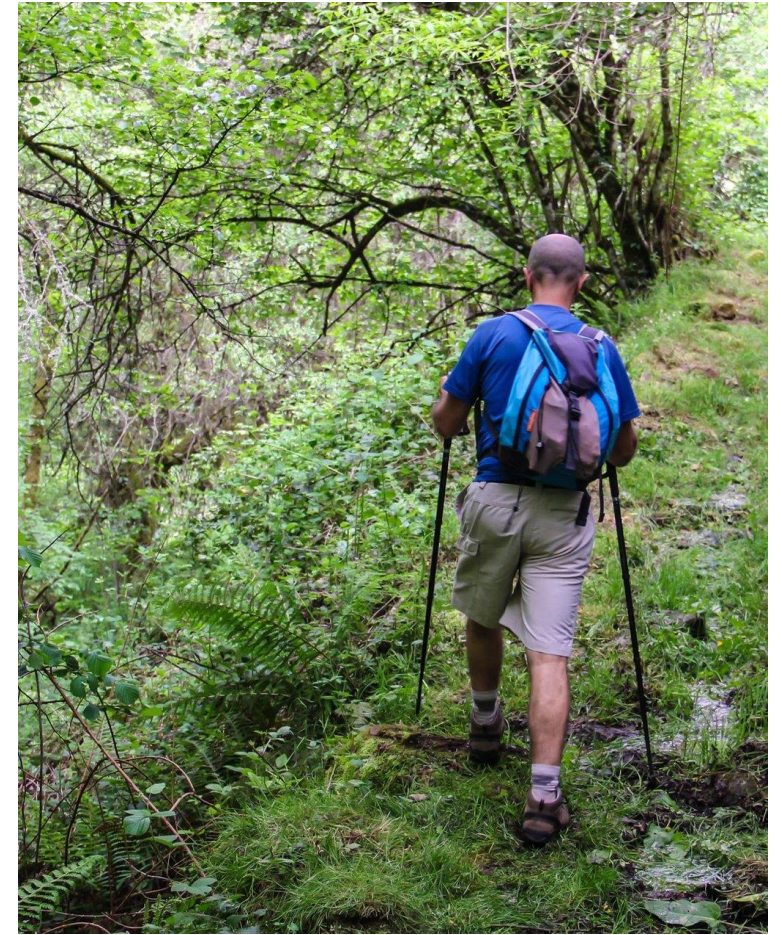
Barroso particularities:

The Barroso forests take up about one third of the region, and are mainly represented by stands of natural woodland of Pyrenean oak (*Quercus pyrenaica*) and maritime pine (*Pinus pinaster*).

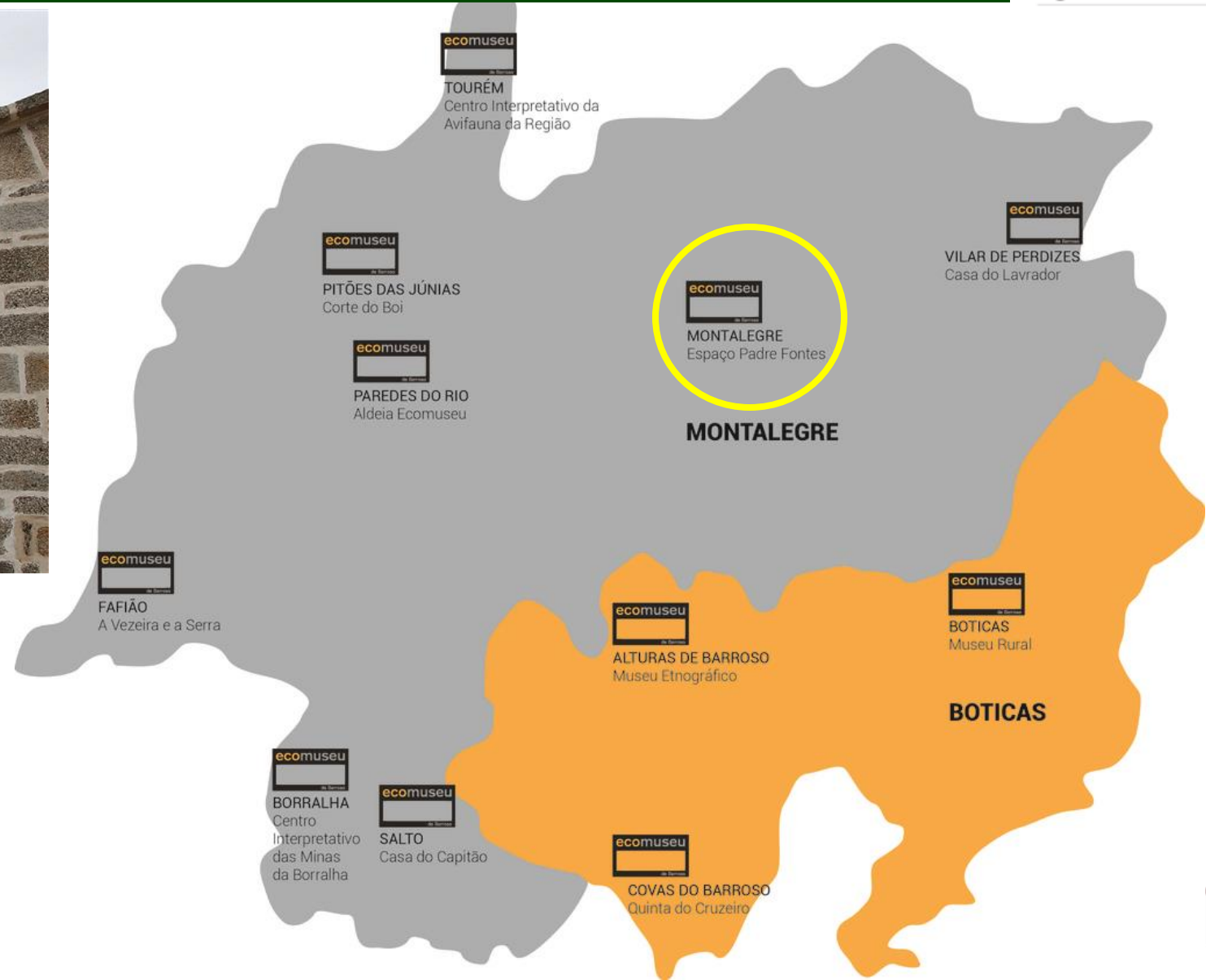
Concept:

The project activities originate some results that are already concluded which are:

- Transnational Strategy for Sustainable Touristic Management;
- Creation of Touristic Packages;
- Elaboration of FAMTRIPS that allow the press and other tourism operators to know and experience the touristic packages;
- Common Promotion Strategy;
- Development of a brand for the commercialization of GIAHS agri-food products and services.

Barroso GIAHS 4.0 - Digital Ecosystem Model



The Association **AquaValor—Water Technology Transference and Valorization Center** had a project proposal approved designated by: **Digital Ecosystem Model for GIAHS: The Barroso Agro-Sylvo-Pastoral System**

As results it is intended to achieve:

- Identification of physical, chemical and biological indicators that most influence the preservation of environmental quality in the Barroso region GIAHS;
- Analysis, specification and modeling of a digital ecosystem that also allows monitoring the environmental quality of the Barroso GIAHS region;
- Development, deployment and testing of a pilot version of the idealized ecosystem.
