A mountainous system in the Mediterranean basin / Iberic Peninsula







The Barroso forests take up about one third of the region, and are mainly represented by stands of natural woodland of Pyrenean oak (*Quercus pyrenaica*) and maritime pine (*Pinus pinaster*).




High quality products - Alto Tâmega Tabernas Network

- Identification of physical, chemical and biological indicators that most influence the preservation of environmental quality in the Barroso region GIAHS;
- Analysis, specification and modeling of a digital ecosystem that also allows monitoring the environmental quality of the Barroso GIAHS region;
- Development, deployment and testing of a pilot version of the idealized ecosystem.
