EUROPEAN PRICE REPORT

Latest trends

Inflation is going down in all major European countries. Annual inflation in the euro area stood at 4.3 percent in September, compared with 5.2 percent in August. In the European Union, the rate was 4.9 percent, compared with 5.9 percent in August. The lowest annual rates were observed in the Netherlands (-0.3 percent), Denmark (0.6 percent) and Belgium (0.7 percent), while the highest were recorded in Hungary (12.2 percent) and Romania (9.2 percent). In the current European Fish Price Report, 46 percent of the prices were stable compared with September 2023, 22 percent went up and 27 percent went down.

Traders, in general, are reluctant to start buying for the Christmas period. The uncertainty is prevailing, especially in view of the impact that present conflicts could have on fuel and energy prices. Next month, for sure, traders will start purchasing seafood for the festivities, and prices are likely to go up, in view of the increasing demand.

GROUNDFISH

Cod continues to be in low supply in all major markets, and the outlook for 2024 is even bleaker. Prices are rising in all major markets. In the Rungis wholesale market in France, cod products have risen by EUR 1.00 per kg between September and October.

After declines in price levels for hake experienced in the opening months of 2023, price have stabilized.

GROUNDFISH (cont.)

Wild turbot prices are declining at the moment, frozen turbot in Spain sells at about EUR 0.30 per kg less than last month. This is a normal development during this period of the year. Cultured turbot remains stable, with some price increases reported for large turbot.

Demand for traditional cured cod products (wet-salted cod fillets from frozen raw material (*Gadus macrocephalus*) and wet-salted cod fillets (*Gadus morhua*) from fresh raw material of Faroese and Icelandic origin) is experiencing a delayed recovery following a summer low due to prolonged high temperatures persisting in southern Europe. The consumption of these products are linked to ancient cultural traditions: being hot dishes, they are consumed with cold temperatures. The climate has started to change, hence the cured cod consumption is expected to return to what it was in previous years. Prices of cured cod are stable.


TUNA - BILLFISHES

The 3-month FAD closure in the Western and Central Pacific ended on 30 September and fishing has been good since then. The skipjack price has fallen with the improving supplies. Major canneries are still reporting poor finished good sales despite the drop in raw material price.


Fishing continues to be slow in the Indian Ocean and raw material inventories at local canneries remain low. Some of the fishing vessels have decided to tie up for the time being due to the poor fishing situation. Despite this, both skipjack and yellowfin prices decreased following the drop in the Bangkok market.

Fishing activity in the Atlantic Ocean has decreased to a moderate-to-poor level. Price of skipjack has risen due to reduced supplies, while the price of yellowfin has decreased due to poor demand.

TUNA - Pacific Ocean





TUNA - Indian/Atlantic Oceans



TUNA - BILLFISHES

The first 72-days IATTC 'veda' ended on 8 October and the second 'veda' will commence on 9 November. About 60 percent of the Eastern Pacific Ocean fleet has opted to be tied up during the second period. Meanwhile, fishing is reported to be good. Skipjack price fell to levels slightly higher than the price in Bangkok. Yellowfin price also weakened due higher proportion of yellowfin in the landings.

The European market price for skipjack increased due to poor catching in the Indian and Atlantic Ocean while yellowfin price remained stable. The indicative price for cooked, single cleaned skipjack loins fell again in line with the worldwide market trend.




CEPHALOPODS

There are plenty of squid arriving from Morocco on the Spanish and Italian market. As a result prices are going down. Similarly, cuttlefish is also abundant in the market, and prices were down by EUR 0.50-0.60 per kg between September and October.

South African squid catches was at a record low of under 200 tonnes for 3 months from July – September. The market seems weak with small fish on offer and prices rapidly declining for this size, EUR 1.00 per kg less than in September. Larger sized squid prices declined of just EUR 0.20 per kg during the last month. The market is weak apparently with fish from Morocco driving levels down.

The octopus market is stronger than the squid and cuttlefish market, with only limited downward price adjustments reported. In the long run, supply is expected to be low, with imminent strict quotas and catch reduction for the Moroccan fleet.

CRUSTACEANS

Demand is weak for crustaceans at the moment. Traders are reluctant to stock for the Christmas festivities, as it is unclear how inflation will proceed and whether fuel prices will go up, taking electricity costs with them. As a result, shrimp prices went down in all of Europe. Christmas purchase will be late this year, similar to 2022, and prices of crustaceans in Europe are likely to go up again in November and December.


Vannamei shrimp in the European market reported strong price decreases. The medium sized shrimp from Ecuador is selling at almost EUR 1.00 per kg less than in September 2023.

Despite the end of the fishing season in Argentina national waters and the delay in the start of the freshwater campaign in Rawson, the presence of high stocks and the demand situation continue to put downward pressure on shrimp prices, which decreased by EUR 0.20 per kg. The exception was for large sized shrimp (10-20 cm per piece) that experienced a EUR 0.30 per kg price increase from September to October.


Italy is a major market for Norway lobster (*Nephrops norvegicus*). In October prices followed the overall downward trend experienced for crustaceans. Medium sized lobster reported a EUR 0.80 per kg decline compared with September.

Lobsters are an exception to the general negative market conditions for crustaceans, showing that luxury items have a different market environment. Prices of European lobster went up in October, in line with the seasonal low production, which slows down significantly in winter months.

CRAB - in France, origin: Europe






BIVALVES

Supply of bivalves is low in Italy, due to the presence of blue crab in the Adriatic Sea, which is impacting the local aquaculture and catch of bivalves, especially mussels and clams. It is reported that in the Goro area, close to Venice, half of the Manila clam production (*Ruditapes philippinarum*) has been wiped out by this invasive species. As a result the already high prices of this clam are going up.

Scallops' prices in Spain are going down, as demand is slow. Price declines of some EUR 0.30-0.40 per kg have been experienced since the summer months.

MUSSEL BOUCHOT - in France




SMALL PELAGICS

The stocks of small pelagics in the North East Atlantic (herring, mackerel, blue whiting) may be in danger of being overfished, according to the International Council for the Exploration of the Sea (ICES). For all three species, the fishing pressure is above the maximum sustainable yield (MSY).

Norway's autumn mackerel season was off to a good start in August. As of the end of August, the Norwegian fleet had already landed 89 890 tonnes of mackerel. However, this was well below landings during the same period in 2022, when 156 391 tonnes were landed. The first-hand price was up from an average of NOK 13.01 per kg in 2022 to NOK 14.74 per kg in 2023.

Mackerel - in Italy, origin: France




FRESHWATER

The United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland has become one of the major markets for pangasius fillets. In the first eight months of the year, the country imported some 10 500 tonnes of this products, 500 tonnes more than in the same period of last year. Viet Nam accounts for more than 99 percent of this quantity. The total value of imports was USD 42.7 million. The unit value declined by 12 percent, from USD 4.34 per kg in August 2022 to USD 3.80 in August 2023.

Spain, which used to be one of the main pangasius importers in the world, reduced its imports in 2023. In the first eight months of the year, some 3 721 tonnes of pangasius were imported, compared to 4 590 tonnes in the same period of last year. The unit value of frozen pangasius fillets in the Spanish market declined sharply from USD 3.80 per kg in August 2022 to USD 3.00 per kg in August 2023.

SALMON

As of 3 October 2023, the volume of Pacific salmon production in the Russian Far East exceeded 600 000 tonnes, and surpassing production of several recent years. Historically the current catch can be compared with the year 2018 when the nation's fishers harvested over 670 000 tonnes throughout the season. Out of this amount, Kamchatka accounted for 490 000 tonnes of Pacific salmon, Sakhalin, more than 63 000 tonnes, Khabarovsk Territory 28 000 tonnes, and Magadan 14 000 tonnes.

Norwegian companies are still discontented with the parliament's decision of income taxes and remain uncertain about how they will face their future investments due to the potential impacts. The 2025 elections with possible changes in the government are now the new hope for the salmon sector considering that tax and fiscal changes for the aquaculture sector could be reversed. Several sources affirm that important changes are expected for this regulation, so investments are still possible.

SALMON (cont.)

The third quarter of 2023 was a historically strong quarter for Norwegian salmon exports in terms of value. A total of 347 700 tonnes of salmon worth NOK 31 billion were exported in the period, down 1 percent in volume but up 13 percent in value, compared to the same period of last year. According to the Norwegian Seafood Council (NSC), this is a record-high export value for salmon in a single quarter, NOK 952 million higher than the previous record quarter, which was in the fourth quarter of 2022. The institution reported that there are now 31 months in a row with an increase in value, but mainly due to the weak Norwegian krone and not an increase in demand.

The main markets for Norwegian salmon in the third quarter were Poland, the United States of America and France, while the reopening in China is boosting this product, with the restaurant sector as a key ally requesting for a big amount of fresh salmon. In the month of September Norway exported 130 700 tonnes of salmon worth NOK 11.2 billion, down 5 percent in volume but up 14 percent in value compared to September 2022.

There are concerns in Scotland about the ongoing Brexit repercussions causing commercial delays for exports entering the EU market. This has incurred substantial costs for businesses, both financially and in terms of time. Producers and companies are urging the government to establish an efficient system to facilitate the process.

According to the Nasdaq Atlantic Salmon Index, fresh HOG salmon (3-6kg) reached NOK 80.14 (EUR 7.01) at week 39, up 7 percent from the previous year. Prices continue a 4-week upward trend from NOK 70.37 (EUR 6.08) since week 35.

Meanwhile, fresh HOG Atlantic salmon (1-3 kg) from Scottish farms delivered to UK factories reached GBP 6.10 (EUR 7.08) at week 38 and showing a stable trend for 4 consecutive weeks.

TROUT

Norway exported 18 900 tonnes of trout worth NOK 1.6 billion in the third quarter of the year, which represented an increase of 15 percent in volume and 10 percent in value compared to the same quarter of last year. According to NSC, this meant a record-high export value for trout in a single quarter i.e in the third quarter of 2022, NOK 145 million higher than the previous record quarter. The United States of America, Ukraine and Japan were the most important markets Norway exported 6 300 tonnes of trout worth NOK 554 million in September, up 6 percent in volume and 12 percent in value compared to the ninth month of last year.


TROUT

NSC database shows that fresh trout (HOG) FOB prices for exports at the Norwegian border reached NOK 72.56 (EUR 6.31) at week 37, up 1.2 percent compared to previous week. This continues an upward trend from week 35, when NOK 69.59 (EUR 6.02) was registered.

SEABREAM/SEABASS

It is thought that seabream harvests will outstrip seabass by 50 000 tonnes in 2023, bringing production to 310 000 tonnes and 260 000 tonnes respectively. While demand for seabass remains firm there is a glut of seabream on the market, a reality that continues to be reflected in divergent prices for the two species. Medium sized seabass currently sells for an average of EUR 8.50 per kg on the Spanish wholesale market, while prices for the previously more expensive seabream were EUR 4.60 per kg. Wholesale prices for Greek fish in Italy were closer, with medium seabass selling for EUR 7.25 per kg and seabream for EUR 6.00 per kg. Large seabass, in particular, remain in acutely short supply and have been able to command a healthy premium over other sizes, currently averaging EUR 13.70 per kg (Mercamadrid).

Trade volumes for seabream were stable in the first half of the year, while seabass saw significant reductions. Türkiye and Greece, the two largest producers, have seen exports in the first six months of the year fall to 42 000 tonnes and 20 000 tonnes, respectively — 11 percent and 20 percent lower than the same period in 2022. It is worth noting that an estimated 25 percent of Turkish production of seabass is destined for its domestic market, a figure that has increased considerably over the past few years.
