



EUROPEAN PRICE REPORT

Latest trends

The inflation rate in the Euro Area declined to 2.4 percent year-on-year in November 2023, reaching its lowest level since July 2021, this rate compares to 2.9 percent in October and 4.3 percent in September. In this European Fish Price Report, 55 percent of the prices were stable compared with November 2023, 22 percent went up and 23 percent went down.

Trade for the Christmas period is in full swing, but many fishery products do not experience the normal price increase for this period of the year. This is mainly because of decreasing inflation. Demand is going up, though, with the exception of shrimp, which is reportedly experiencing low demand. Lobster and Norway lobster experienced very strong price hikes. Salmon, another fish species associated with Christmas festivities, also reported price increases after some months of lower price levels.

GROUNDFISH

December is the main sales period for wet-salted cod fillets from frozen raw material (*Gadus macrocephalus*) and wet-salted cod fillets (*Gadus morhua*). In the southern part of the continent these products are tied to a Christmas culinary tradition. Traditionally, consumption of these products decreases in January every year. However, the anticipated low temperatures are expected to boost consumption of these products. Prices are expected to fall, especially for *Gadus morhua*, because fishing begins in the Lofoten Islands.

GROUNDFISH (cont.)


Prices for small headed and gutted (H&G) frozen cod and saithe have continued to drop on Norway's auctions in recent weeks, with the usual pre-Christmas upturn still yet to appear. The present price (15 December) of H&G cod is NOK 44.8 per kg which compares to NOK 53 per kg in December 2022.

Hake prices are declining in the European market, especially in Spain. Further reductions are likely once the new Alaska pollack season starts in January in the United States of America, competing with hake in the European market.

TUNA - BILLFISHES

Fishing in the Western and Central Pacific remains good but is showing some signs of slowing down in recent days. Due to the good fishing last month, Bangkok Port is now facing congestion. As a result, some carriers are being diverted away from the Bangkok market. With the good fishing, skipjack prices in Thailand continue to fall.

Fishing in the Indian Ocean has reduced to the moderate-to-poor level. Raw material inventories at local canneries are sufficient for now. Some fishing vessels are being tied up again due to poor fishing. The skipjack price remained at the last month's price level, while yellowfin price increased slightly due to the supply shortage.





Fishing in the Atlantic Ocean has improved slightly to the moderate level. Prices remain unchanged and higher than in other markets due to the short supplies.

TUNA – BILLFISHES (cont.)

The second 72-days IATTC ‘veda’ is in force until 19 January 2024 and about 60% of the Eastern Pacific Ocean fleet has opted to be tied up during this period. Fishing for the vessels that are still operating during the veda is reported to be at the moderate level. Skipjack price has declined sharply, closing the gap with the Thai market, while yellowfin price remains stable.


Some carriers from Western and Central Pacific continue to be diverted to canneries in Latin America. The European market prices for both skipjack and yellowfin rebound due to improving demand and the supply shortage from Indian and Atlantic Oceans. On the contrary, the price for cooked, single cleaned skipjack loins declined marginally.



CEPHALOPODS

Octopus catches have been abundant in Indonesia resulting in lower prices these days. December is usually the peak season for octopus catches, but this year the late rainy season caused some shifts in trends. Prices are expected to stay low because demand is bleak until the end of this year.

Catches of squid are very poor in South Africa, hence prices moved up by EUR 0.10 per kg for medium and bigger squid, while small squid prices stayed stable. There was some discussion about closing all fishing in December, but this did not obtain enough support.






CRUSTACEANS

Raw material supply of shrimp from Indonesia has come down gradually since early December. Nevertheless, shrimp farmers are hesitant to harvest due to the very low prices. Meanwhile, some farmers struggle to survive as prices are lower than farming costs, and they are considering to delay the stocking of ponds with baby shrimp. Other farmers are opting to keep the shrimp in the ponds hoping for better demand in the next month. This is likely as the Chinese New Year will create a strong demand in the domestic market and impact the European and US markets. In the European market, selling prices of Indonesian shrimp went down by about USD 0.10 per kg.


Prices of Argentinian shrimp are reported stable in the European market for large shrimp. Small shrimps on the contrary are being sold at EUR 0.50 per kg less than last month. Within one year, price of small Argentine shrimp reportedly reduced by EUR 1.00 per kg. For large shrimp, on the contrary, prices increased by EUR 0.60 per kg between December 2022 and December 2023.

Lobster is a main festivity food item, and in fact demand for lobster is very strong. Prices went through the roof, increasing by EUR 15.00 per kg in just one month. It is expected that this trend will reverse in January. Crab prices also are going up, in view of good demand and low domestic production in Europe.

CRAB - in France, origin: Europe






BIVALVES

With autumn now well underway, the blue crab has entered a sort of natural hibernation. Looting of clam and mussel farms in the Po Delta has decreased, but tensions between producers have not decreased, exhausted by losses of almost 1 billion euros. Concerns remain about the future of one of the most flourishing sectors of the fishing economy.

Fishing for clams and mussels is becoming uneconomical, due to the very limited availability of bivalves in the water. Fishers in the Goro area will continue fishing until January and then stop. Fishers from the other two major producing areas close to Venice, namely Scardovari and Comacchio, on the other hand, have been at a standstill for months. Having to fight against the same enemy has pushed producers to make a common front by creating an inter-regional technical committee to face this emergency together. Fishers are waiting for the resources of Ministry of Agriculture to be disbursed, which will be used to cover the costs of disposing the crabs that the market does not want and to repay the plundered juveniles.

Under these conditions, fishers will not restart production for 2024. This will create a major problem for Italian clam consumers, given that six out of seven Italians do not want to replace clams produced in Italy with those caught in the Pacific. A Marshall Plan is needed to restart the production of bivalve molluscs, from clams to mussels otherwise in the next three years there is a risk of a loss of EUR 1 billion. With a harvest of 50 000 tonnes per year, Italy is the first European producer and the second largest producer in the world of clams, while the production of mussels normally ranges from 50 000 to 80 000 tonnes.

MUSSEL BOUCHOT - in France




Monthly average consumer prices in metropolitan France

SMALL PELAGICS

Norwegian frozen mackerel exports declined sharply in 2023. In the first ten months of the year some 225 000 tonnes of this product were exported, which compares to 265 000 tonnes in the same period of 2022. Total export value was USD 440 million in the Jan-Oct 2023 period, down from USD 483 million of the same period in 2022. Due to lower catches of mackerel, the unit value increased from USD 1.78 per kg in October 2022 to USD 2.02 per kg. This year is the first time that the unit value of frozen mackerel exceeds USD 2.00 per kg.

Japan is the main market for frozen mackerel from Norway, increasing its imports from 45 000 tonnes in the first ten months of 2022 to 53 000 tonnes in the same period of

2023. Other Asian countries which are top importers of this product are the Republic of Korea, China and Viet Nam. China reported a huge decline in frozen mackerel imports between 2022 and 2023, decreasing from 50 000 tonnes in Jan-Oct 2022 to 20 000 tonnes in Jan-Oct 2023.

Norwegian frozen mackerel exports (in 1 000 tonnes)



FRESHWATER

Imports of frozen pangasius fillets into the European Union were lower in the first eight months of 2023 when compared with the same period of 2022. The total value in January to August 2023 was USD 144 million, down from USD 156 million reported for the same period of 2022. During this period, Germany emerged as a major importer increasing imports from USD 18 million in 2022 to USD 27 million.

The Kingdom of the Netherlands is still the main importer, but most of these products are reexported to neighbouring countries. Spain and Italy, generally important markets for fishery products, reported strong decreases in imports of frozen pangasius fillets, down by 32 and 37 percent respectively. Viet Nam is the main supplier of this commodity, accounting for 90 percent of EU imports. The unit value of frozen pangasius fillets declined slightly, from USD 3.50 per kg in the first eight months of 2022 to USD 3.40 per kg in the same period of 2023.



SALMON

Norwegian total seafood exports surpassed the 2022 full-year figure by mid-November, reflecting that 2023 will be a very good year for the sector. According to the Norwegian Seafood Council (NSC), November was a particularly good month for salmon. Volume growth and higher prices compared to the same period last year show that there is an increase in demand for the species in the market. In addition, the currency effect was the most important contributor to the increase in export value for salmon.

Norway exported 128 324 tonnes of salmon worth NOK 11.7 billion in November, representing increases of 3 percent in volume and a notable 18 percent growth in value compared to the same month of last year. Poland, France, and Netherlands (Kingdom of the) were the biggest markets in the month with the former registering the greatest increase in export value (up NOK 568 million, or 43 percent), compared to November 2022.

SALMON (cont.)


European household consumption of smoked salmon is reviving following the decline during the pandemic with some major countries in Europe increasing purchases. With the most important season for smoked salmon sales upcoming, this means that Poland will lead the growth.

In Scotland, HMRC data showed that in the first nine months of the year 53 000 tonnes of salmon were exported worth GBP 478 million (up GBP 33 million). According to the trade body Salmon Scotland, this confirms Scottish salmon's position as the UK's top food export.

In terms of main markets, the European Union accounted for 60 percent of the total share while France remains the single largest market. Meanwhile, exports beyond the European Union increased 15 percent and particularly to the United States of America up 11 percent to GBP 113 million. Scottish salmon continues to gain popularity and expand in Asian markets with increases of 41 percent in value and 42 percent in volume to GBP 66 million and 5 400 tonnes.

FOB prices for whole fresh Norwegian Atlantic salmon (sales to export markets at the Norwegian border) increased slightly from NOK 83.74 (EUR 7.07) at week 46 to NOK 84.07 (EUR 7.21) at week 47, following a 3-week consecutive stable trend.

In addition, prices of fresh HOG Atlantic salmon (1-3 kg) from Scottish farms delivered to UK factories remained constant for 3 consecutive weeks (45 to 47) at GBP 8.45 (variable in EUR) after jumping from GBP 7.60 at week 43.





TROUT

Norway exported 6 397 tonnes of trout worth NOK 561 million in November which meant an increase of 31 percent in terms of volume and 25 percent in value compared to the same month of last year. The three main markets in the eleventh month were Ukraine, the United States of America, and Lithuania. In particular, according to the NSC, it was the first time since the war started that Ukraine ranked as the biggest market for trout. Ukraine had the largest increase in value this month (up NOK 54 million, or 171 percent) compared to the same month last year; while in volume terms 1 174 tonnes represented an increase of 148 percent under the same comparison.

The NSC database shows that fresh trout (HOG) FOB prices to export markets at the Norwegian border reached NOK 79.54 (EUR 6.82) at week 47, down 2.63 percent compared to the previous week. This interrupted an upward trend from week 44 to week 46, but at major scale, there is a large upward trend since week 35 with NOK 69.59 (EUR 6.02).

SEABREAM/SEABASS

As is typical for the seabass and seabream market, the winter season means lower demand. This, combined with a slower than anticipated summer season, poses significant difficulties for farmers. Producer associations in a number of countries have flagged the challenges that they are now facing, particularly as their margins are squeezed by higher costs and softening prices. Indeed, pen biomass levels are thought to be significantly higher than this time last year, with many farmers choosing to delay harvest. This is both in the hope of stronger prices in the Spring, but also as a means to target more premium subsectors of the market such as the restaurant trade.

Prices have continued to soften in the later part of the year, except for larger fish for which prices remain robust. This is a continuation of the downward trend seen since April this year, as a less busy than expected summer season meant that demand was weak. Consequently, trade volumes have experienced a period of stagnation across most major markets. The following table details the variations in trade volumes by country, illustrating the current situation in different markets.

There remains a significant price gap between seabass and seabream. Small and medium seabream, the most sold categories of the fish, have remained fixed to their low summertime level. Both sizes were selling for around EUR 4.70 per kg (Spain, wholesale) in early December 2023, far lower than the price of EUR 6.90 that the two gradings commanded in March this year.

Prices for seabass were notably higher, at EUR 5.00 per kg for small fish and EUR 8.15 per kg for medium sized fish, although as with prices for small and medium sized seabream this is significantly lower than their previous peak earlier in the year.
