


Overview of the damage to agricultural land and infrastructure due to the conflict in the Gaza Strip as of 1 December 2023




Proportional damage to cropland in the Gaza Strip

This assessment has been conducted based on available satellite imagery, ancillary data and remote sensing analysis for the period of 7 October - 1 December 2023 without field validation. Land cover data from 2021 was used as baseline data due to limited availability for data collection in the area of interest and time constraints related to the nature of the report. This assessment was conducted by the Geospatial Unit at the Land and Water Division (NSL) of FAO and will be further complemented with additional field assessment and use of very high-resolution imagery.
