An **annual core survey** on crop, livestock, aquaculture, fishery, and forestry production (**CORE**), and a **set of specialized tools** in rotation:

- Costs linked to agricultural production/ income; labor and productivity; gender decision-making (ILP)
- Production practices and environmental aspects of farming (PME)
- Machinery and equipment used for agricultural production (MEA)



VALUE ADDED OF THE 50x2030 APPROACH

- Improved coverage and scope: targets all agricultural production units in the country (agricultural household and corporate producers), covers crop and livestock; could cover fisheries when relevant
- Improved comparability and coherence by using international concepts and definitions
- Improved data quality in terms of relevance, accuracy, timeliness, accessibility
- Provides accurate figures on production of **agricultural commodities as basis for food systems**
- Covers **different economic, technical and environmental aspects** linked to the agricultural production



First lessons learned from 3 years of implementation

- Long-term support useful for establishing a permanent system of agricultural statistical surveys.
- Integration with existing national systems of surveys and census operations is key.
- **Modular approach** of 50x2030 tools allow the integration of specific modules with country relevance.
- Implementation is facilitated when **initial strengthening of capacities** took place (example of GSARS).
- Important efforts needed on specific operations such as **data cleaning and data dissemination** for guaranteeing a high level of quality for data and open access to users.
- **High level of governance** at country level is crucial for being able to match the deadlines (ag surveys are seasonal...) and make resources available at the right time for data collection.
