



EUROPEAN PRICE REPORT

Latest trends

From 1 January to 15 December 2023, exports of fish and seafood from the Russian Federation amounted to 2.08 million tonnes, according to the Customs Service statistics and Rosselkhoznadzor's Argus information system. This represents a 30 percent increase over the same period in 2022, when Russian exports of fish and seafood were just over 1.6 million tonnes. China has become the largest export destination; the seafood shipments to this country have increased almost three times, exceeding 1.2 million tonnes. In second place is the Republic of Korea, which absorbed supplies of almost half a million tonnes, followed by the Netherlands, Belarus and Japan. The volume of exports of Russian finfish and other seafood to these countries amounted to 117 000, 65 600 and 33 500 tonnes, respectively.

In 2023, consumer prices in Germany for fish and fish products increased by around 14.65 percent compared to the previous year. During this period, consumer prices for other food rose by twelve percent, showing that the increase in fish prices was higher than many other food items.

The recent crisis in the Rea Sea is having an impact on international transport costs. The latest price of USD 3 964 per 40ft shipping container is the highest since October 2022 and is 179 percent more than the average 2019 (pre-COVID-19 pandemic) rate of USD 1 420. Nevertheless, the present container cost is still far below the peak of USD 10 377 reached in September 2021. The impact of higher container costs, plus longer and more expensive transport through alternate routes, will soon have an impact on seafood prices in the European market, which relies heavily on imports from Asia, normally passing through the Suez channel.


Latest trends (cont.)

The euro area annual inflation rate was 2.8 percent in January 2024, down from 2.9 percent in December. A year earlier, the rate was 8.6 percent. European Union annual inflation was 3.1 percent in January 2024, down from 3.4 percent in December 2023. A year earlier, the rate was 10.0 percent. In this European Fish Price Report, 64 percent of the prices did not change compared with January 2024, with some rises noted for 16 percent of seafood products and declines for 20 percent.

GROUNDFISH

The 2024 Alaska pollack season has already started in the United States of America, where the quota is slightly higher than the 2023 allocation. On the other hand, a sizeable increase in the quota is reported for Russian Alaska pollack this year. The United States of America has banned imports of Russian Alaska pollack, including product which has been re-processed in China. This is having a significant impact on the market due to the notable gap in supply. Meanwhile, US surimi producers have yet to agree on pricing with their traditional buyers in Japan.

Cod quotas have been cut in the Barents Sea and current prices are high as a result of the cod being slow to arrive along the Norwegian coast. Southern European markets for cured cod are in trepidation while waiting to see when the cod banks arrive, a factor that could drastically change the prices of wet-salted cod products. On the consumption front, the market is quiet as at present there is no major interest in wet-salted cod products; however, this will change in the Holy Week (before Easter) during late March.



TUNA - BILLFISHES




Tuna fishing in the Western and Central Pacific Ocean has slowed down to moderate levels due to bad weather. Meanwhile, Bangkok Port remains congested with a backlog of carriers waiting for berth space. With the ample supply of raw material waiting to be unloaded, skipjack prices continue to fall to about USD 1 350 per tonne, the lowest level since October 2021.

Fishing in the Indian Ocean remains at a moderate level. Skipjack prices are low but yellowfin remains stable.

The International Commission for the Conservation of Atlantic Tunas (ICCAT)'s 72-day FAD closure in the Atlantic Ocean is in effect until 13 March 2024. Fishing is

reported to be poor due to this closure. Yellowfin is seeing price increases due to the short supplies but skipjack prices remain stable despite the low catches. Several boats have taken the opportunity to perform repairs and dry dock.

The second "veda" implemented by the Inter-American Tropical Tuna Commission (IATTC) in the Eastern Pacific Ocean ended on 19 January and fishing is reported to be good, especially in Peruvian waters. Fishing effort is up to around 65-70 percent, with the catches being mainly skipjack. Raw material inventories at local canneries are healthy. The skipjack price is down, while the yellowfin price remains steady.


Market prices in Europe for both skipjack and yellowfin remain the same as in January 2024. The price for cooked, single-cleaned skipjack loins has rebounded in Spain due an increase in demand.



CEPHALOPODS

Demand for both squid and octopus increased in Europe in the opening month of the year, which is quite a surprise as normally during this period, demand is rather slow. Prices were quite high for all cephalopod products.

Squid catches in South Africa are very low, possibly because the current elevated water temperature deters the squid from rising to the surface. With these limited catches, prices remain high.




CRUSTACEANS

The political instability in Ecuador kept shrimp supply low for the start of 2024. As a result, Ecuadorian product is missing in the market, and other suppliers are able to fetch higher prices for their shrimp products.


Cold storage holdings of Argentine red shrimp are low in Spain. In addition, demand is expected to be high during the Holy Week, which is traditionally the main consumption period for seafood in Spain. These factors, together with on-land processing being lower than normal during this period of the year, are contributing to higher shrimp prices in Spain. Except for the smallest sizes (40–60 per kg), prices of shrimp went up by EUR 0.20 per kg between January and February 2024.

This period of the year is an off-season for crab and lobster landings, and at the same time, demand is slow apart from Saint Valentine's Day, when lobster is a demanded restaurant item.

CRAB - in France, origin: Europe




BIVALVES

The total value of clam imports into the European Union was USD 320 million in 2023, declining from USD 380 million in 2022 and USD 409 million in 2021. The main clam market in the European Union is Spain, accounting for over 50 percent of the clams imported into the bloc.

About seventy percent of the EU imports of clams originates in other EU countries. Portugal, the Netherlands and Italy are the main suppliers of clams to the neighbouring EU countries, contributing about USD 60 million each in 2021. There was a change in these trade patterns last year, with Portuguese and Italian clam exports declining to USD 36 million and USD 44 million respectively, while the Netherlands reported steady exports.


MUSSEL BOUCHOT - in France



SMALL PELAGICS

In recent years, the combined catches of mackerel, Atlanto-Scandian herring, blue whiting and capelin have exceeded scientific recommendations by more than 4.5 million tonnes. Researchers have also warned that small pelagic species in the North Atlantic may be over-exploited. Accordingly, scientists are now recommending reduced quotas for stocks of both mackerel and herring in the North Sea. The coastal States have agreed on a 2024 Total Allowable Catch (TAC) of 739 387 tonnes for mackerel in the North Sea, in line with scientific advice.

Mackerel - in Italy, origin: France




SMALL PELAGICS (cont.)

Norwegian exports of mackerel were off to a good start in the new year (2024), with prices and volumes rising, according to the Norwegian Seafood Council (NSC). However, the price picture is blurred by the effect of a very weak Norwegian krone (NOK) against major global currencies. While prices in NOK rose by 2.7 percent during the first week of the year compared to the same week in 2023, in US dollar terms there was a decline of 3.9 percent.

For herring, the quota for spring-spawning herring was set at 390 010 tonnes, to be divided between Norway, the Russian Federation, the European Union, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, and the Faroe Islands. The 2024 quota represents a 24 percent decrease in TAC compared to the 2023 TAC of 511 171 tonnes.

FRESHWATER

Tilapia is not a very important seafood item in the European Union. Annual imports are quite stable over the years, at around USD 260 million. China is the main supplier of this commodity, exporting some USD 35 million in 2023. The Netherlands is an important trade partner, mainly importing and re-exporting tilapia products. By far the main product form are frozen tilapia fillets.




SALMON

Norway exported 86 985 tonnes of salmon worth NOK 9.8 billion in January of 2024, which meant a decrease of two percent in terms of volume but a growth of 11 percent in value compared to the same month of the previous year. Rising salmon prices and a weakened krone were the main drivers for this increase in value. For instance, data from the Norwegian Seafood Council (NSC) recorded that the average export price for fresh whole salmon in January was NOK 107.09 per kg, which is 15 percent above the average export price registered in the same month last year.

According to the NSC, this scenario is in line with a pattern that has been observed for the first month during the previous three years, where lower supplies have generated robust growth in prices compared to the same period in the previous year, and the result is an increase in the exported value of the species.

Poland, France and the United States of America were the top markets for the species in that month.



TROUT

According to the NSC, both trout production and exports have historically had significant fluctuations and recent years have been no exception. From a decline in 2023, the sector recovered by 2024 to reach the 2022 level measured in volume.

Norway exported 4 584 tonnes of trout worth NOK 439 million in the first month of 2024, reflecting significant growths of 49 percent and 43 percent, respectively, compared to January last year.

The main important markets for the species were the United States of America, Thailand and Ukraine, with the latter registering the biggest increase in terms of value during the month (up 264 percent).


In terms of product types, fresh whole trout has increased its dominance measured in value, accounting for 71 percent of the exports during January 2024, compared to 57 percent in the same month last year.

SEABREAM/SEABASS

Sales in January and February 2024 remained low, with weak demand keeping the market steady. Trade was slow in Spain's Mercamadrid, with January volumes of 982 tonnes of seabass sold and 810 tonnes of seabream sold. Having stayed low throughout much of 2023, seabream prices have seen a strong rally, with prices for small- and medium-sized fish rising considerably, reaching EUR 5.93 per kg and EUR 6.30 per kg, respectively, on the Spanish market. Fish sold on the Italian market in February 2024 saw a similar increase of between 20–25 percent from January 2024 levels.

Meanwhile, prices for small and large seabass have kept close to the elevated levels seen in the latter months of 2023. Medium-sized fish saw a slight decline, with Greek fish on the Spanish market standing at EUR 7.75 per kg in January 2024, down from EUR 8.60 per kg in September 2023.

Trade volumes rose slightly in 2023, although year-on-year growth was below the levels in previous years. Greece, the largest exporter by volume, saw imports remain stable at 121 000 tonnes. Following a slight drop in 2022, Turkish exporters had a good year in 2023, with volumes growing by nine percent to 106 000 tonnes. Despite being a net importer, Spain has, in recent years, become the third largest exporter of seabass and seabream, overtaking Italy. The main destination for Spanish exports is Portugal; Portuguese imports of seabass and seabream from Spain have risen from 8 200 tonnes in 2021 to 14 100 tonnes in 2023.
