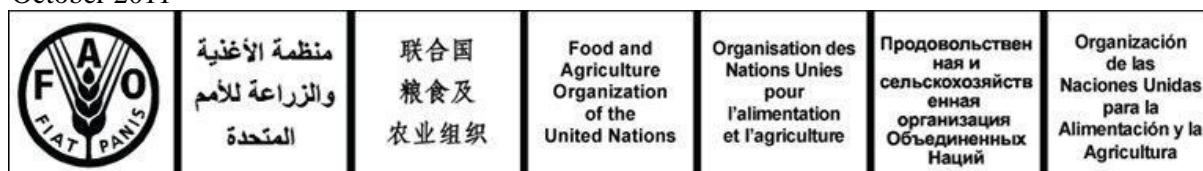

### Membership of the WFP Executive Board

#### Suggested Action by the Council

In accordance with Resolution 7/2011, adopted by the 37<sup>th</sup> Session of the FAO Conference on 2 July 2011, the Council is required to elect six FAO Member Nations to the WFP Executive Board for a term of office of three years to fill the following seats:

- 2 seats from List A (including the rotating seat for the period 2012-2014)
- 1 seat from List C
- 2 seats from List D
- 1 seat from List E

The attached nomination form should be completed by Member Nations which wish to stand for the above seats and submitted to the Secretary-General of the Conference and Council by 12:00 hours on Monday, 14 November 2011.

1. For purposes of election to the Board, FAO Member Nations are divided into five separate lists (A, B, C, D and E) as shown on the FAO Council Web page under “Other Documents”:

2. The Council is required to elect six members for a term of office expiring on 31 December 2014 to replace those whose terms end on 31 December 2011, i.e. Egypt (List A); Brazil<sup>1</sup> and Colombia (List C); Denmark and Ireland (List D); and Slovenia (List E).

3. Outgoing members are eligible for re-election.

4. A nomination form is given in the Appendix.

<sup>3</sup> Switzerland resigned from the WFP Executive Board on 31 December 2010, and the Council agreed that Ireland would occupy this List D seat for the remainder of the term of office to 31 December 2011.

<sup>4</sup> Luxembourg resigned from the WFP Executive Board on 31 December 2010, and ECOSOC agreed that Spain would occupy this List D seat for the remainder of the term of office to 31 December 2011
