1. For purposes of election to the Board, FAO Member Nations are divided into five separate lists (A, B, C, D and E) as shown on the FAO Council Web page under "Additional Information": <http://www.fao.org/about/meetings/council/cl160/en/>
2. The Council is required to elect six members for a term of office expiring on 31 December 2021 to replace the ones whose term ends on 31 December 2018, i.e. Afghanistan (B), Benin (A), Kuwait (B), Peru (C), Switzerland (D) and United States of America (D).
3. Outgoing members are eligible for re-election.

⁴ The Netherlands resigned its seat effective 31 December 2017, with New Zealand completing the term of office from 1 January 2018 to 31 December 2018.

⁵ Zimbabwe and Angola reached an agreement to share an FAO Council elected seat, with Zimbabwe serving in 2017 and 2018, and Angola serving in 2019.

⁶ Mexico and Colombia reached an agreement to share an ECOSOC-elected seat with Mexico serving in 2017 and Colombia in 2018 and 2019.

⁷ Finland and Spain resigned their seats effective 31 December 2017 and Greece and Norway were to complete their terms of office from 1 January 2018 to 31 December 2019. However, at an ECOSOC Coordination and Management Meeting held on 16 April 2018, it was agreed that Greece and Norway would resign their seats effective 31 December 2018, with Luxembourg and Spain completing their terms of office from 1 January 2019 to 31 December 2019.
