## **Introduction to Item 22: Technical Cooperation Programme's resource allocation shares**

In November 2020, the Joint Meeting of the 129th Session of the Programme Committee and 183rd Session of the Finance Committee requested FAO to begin a strategic exercise, in consultation with Members, aimed at reviewing aspects of the Technical Cooperation Programme (TCP) documented in the 2020 TCP Evaluation and efforts initiated by Management to re-imagine the TCP.

A key component of the strategic exercise was to reconsider the regional TCP resource shares which had remained unchanged since the biennium 2010-2011. Between March 2021 and December 2022, a new methodology to calculate regional resource shares was developed in close consultation with Members. Through a series of informal consultations and formal Governing Bodies sessions, Members agreed on a set of weighted criteria and calculation methodology. The resulting revised shares were endorsed by the 171st Session of the Council (5-9 December 2022).

The agreed shares, after deducting resources reserved for emergency and interregional TCP managed from headquarters, are: Africa 40.3 percent; Asia and the Pacific 24.5 percent; Europe 8.3 percent; Latin America and the Caribbean 18.3 percent; and Near East and North Africa 8.6 percent.

In line with Conference Resolution 1/2008 (<u>C 2008/REP, E26, para 35</u>), Council is to review these shares periodically. The Programme of Work and Budget 2024-25 reflects the revised regional TCP resource shares in its detailed budget proposal for approval by the Conference.
