SECOND REPORT OF THE GENERAL COMMITTEE (RE-ADMISSION OF SOUTH AFRICA)

1. With reference to its first report of 6 November 1993 on the Admission of New Member Nations, the Committee reaffirmed its position on the re-admission of South Africa and recommends to the Conference that the secret ballot on this item should take place on Tuesday 9 November 1993 at 16.00 hours.

2. The Committee, bearing in mind the current status of South Africa within the United Nations Organization, further recommends that, should the Member Nations vote in favour of the re-admission of South Africa, the Conference should thereby decide to re-admit South Africa as a Member of the Organization, with full participation rights to take effect as from the date on which the Transitional Executive Council is instituted and commences functioning.
