### MULTILATERAL TREATIES DEPOSITED WITH THE DIRECTOR-GENERAL

#### I. INTRODUCTION

After the issuance of document C 89/10, the following developments have taken place up to 2 November 1989.

#### II. CONVENTIONS AND AGREEMENTS CONCLUDED UNDER ARTICLE XIV OF THE FAO CONSTITUTION

##### International Plant Protection Convention

On 13 July 1989, the Government of the German Democratic Republic deposited an instrument of acceptance of the amendments to the Convention.

##### Plant Protection Agreement for the Asia and Pacific Region

On 24 October 1989, the Government of Australia deposited an instrument of acceptance of the amendment to Article I(a) of the Agreement approved by the FAO Council in November 1983.

#### III. CONVENTIONS AND AGREEMENTS CONCLUDED OUTSIDE THE FRAMEWORK OF FAO IN RESPECT OF WHICH THE DIRECTOR-GENERAL EXERCISES DEPOSITARY FUNCTIONS

##### Convention on the Conservation of the Living Resources of the Southeast Atlantic

On 19 July 1989, the Government of Portugal deposited an instrument of acceptance of the amendments to Articles VIII, XVII, XIX and XXI of the Convention.

##### International Convention for the Conservation of Atlantic Tunas

By instrument received on 12 March 1987, confirmed on 3 January and 27 October 1989, the Government of the Republic of Senegal deposited a notification of withdrawal from the Convention.

##### Agreement for the Establishment of the Intergovernmental Organization for Marketing Information and Technical Advisory Services for Fishery Products in the Asia and Pacific Region (INFOFISH)

With reference to document C 89/10, page 33, the date of ratification by the Government of Indonesia to the above-mentioned Agreement was inadvertently omitted. This date should read: 9 October 1987.
