### SECOND REPORT OF THE CREDENTIALS COMMITTEE

- 1. The Credentials Committee held its second meeting on 15 November 1989 at 08.45 hours.
- 2. In accordance with Rule III-2 of the General Rules of the Organization, the Credentials Committee examined the Credentials of 18 Member Nations and found them to be in order, thus bringing the total to 150 Credentials. One Member Nation has not registered to date (Appendix A).
- 3. In addition to the four Member Nations which have already notified the Organization that they will not be attending the Twenty-fifth Session of the Conference (mentioned in the previous report ), the following three Member Nations have also advised that they will not be represented:

- 4. The Credentials Committee also examined the Credentials of the United Nations and other organizations of the United Nations System and found them to be in order (Appendix B).
- 5. The Committee wished to record its satisfaction at the number of Credentials deposited by Member Nations which had been signed by Members of Government of the highest rank.
