## **29th AFRICA REGIONAL CONFERENCE** *REPORT OF THE SUBREGIONAL CONSULTATIONS* EASTERN AFRICA

#### Introduction

The Eastern Africa Sub-Regional Consultations was attended by member states as well as observers from the African Development Bank (AfDB), and Desert Locust Control Organization of Eastern Africa (DLCO-EA).

The Hon Minister of Agriculture, Ethiopia chaired the meeting, while the Uganda Permanent Representative to FAO, Rome served as rapporteur. The Sub-Regional Coordinator, Sub-Regional Office for Eastern Africa presented a review of priorities proposed for the sub-region in 2014. Achievements, experiences and lessons learnt from the implementation of priorities were also presented.

A draft list of proposed priorities prepared based on prior consultations with FAO Country Offices, two retreats of the Multi-Disciplinary Teams (MDT) as well as consultation with IGAD was also presented. Following the presentation, delegates discussed and reviewed the list and came up with a list of priorities for the 2016-2017.

### Priority activities for 2016-2017

The following are the agreed priorities as formulated and endorsed by the Eastern Africa subregional consultation, that took place on 07th April 2016 in Abidjan, Cote d'Ivoire.

1. Promote sustainable use and management of NR to address the root causes & impact of drought and climate change

### 2. Agricultural transformation, taking advantage of the youth dividend, through

- I. Agro-industrialization
- II. Commercialization of agriculture, agro-food parks
- III. Public-Private partnership for agribusiness development
- IV. Value chain development with emphasis on technologies along specific value chains (crops, livestock, fisheries,)
- V. Promotion of intra-regional trade

# 3. Increasing agricultural production, productivity of crops, livestock and fisheries sectors through

- I. Agricultural mechanization
- II. Intensification and expansion of agricultural production
- III. Small-scale irrigation schemes
- IV. Access to inputs including seeds and fertilizers and livestock feeds and services
- V. Control of cross-boundary disease and pests

### 4. Support the design and revision of sub-regional policies /frameworks

- Sustainable Agricultural Production
- FSN sensitive agriculture and Malabo declaration commitments
