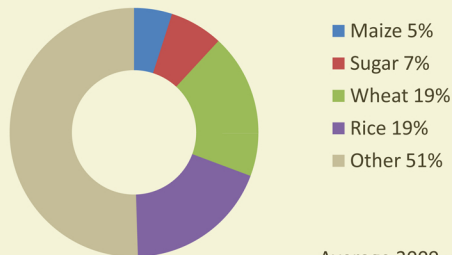
Today, wheat is grown on more land area than any other commercial crop and continues to be the most important food grain source for humans.

GLOBAL PRODUCTION IS APROX. **700 million tonnes**

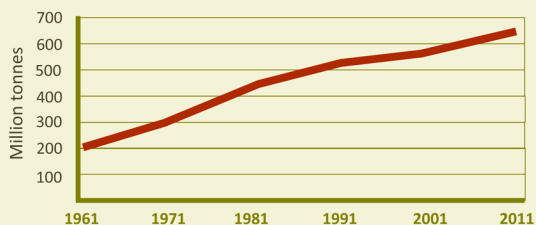


WHEAT PROVIDES **19%** OF OUR TOTAL AVAILABLE CALORIES
