

### Appointment of the Chairperson and the First Alternate Chairperson of the Appeals Committee

1. Staff Regulation 301.11.1 provides as follows:

*“The Director-General shall establish a Committee within the Organization to advise him in cases of appeal by individual staff members regarding a grievance arising out of disciplinary action or arising out of an administrative decision which staff members allege to be in conflict, either in substance or in form, with the terms of their appointment or with any pertinent Staff Regulation, Staff Rule or administrative directive. At the request of the staff member, the Director-General may render a final decision without recourse being made to the said Committee. The Committee shall consist of two members and five alternate members nominated by the Director-General, two members and five alternate members elected by the staff as a whole, and an independent Chairman appointed by the Council. The Council shall appoint two alternate Chairmen to serve when the Chairman is unavailable; if the Chairman and alternate Chairmen are unavailable, the remainder of the Committee may select an ad hoc Chairman who shall not be a staff member.”*

2. At its 119<sup>th</sup> Session (2000) the Council appointed His Excellency Francis Montanaro Mifsud, Ambassador and Representative of the Republic of Malta to FAO, as the Chairperson of the Appeals Committee, and Mr Denis Cangy, Consul of Mauritius in Rome, as Second Alternate Chairperson of the Appeals Committee.

3. At its 126<sup>th</sup> Session (2003) the Council appointed His Excellency Henri Fissore, Ambassador and Permanent Representative of the Principality of Monaco to FAO, as First Alternate Chairperson of the Appeals Committee.

4. On 14 October 2011, Ambassador Mifsud informed the Director-General of his desire to relinquish the functions of Chairperson of the Appeals Committee.

5. Following the completion of his assignment in Rome, Ambassador Fissore resigned from his duties as Alternate Chairperson in July 2006.

6. The Council is requested to consider the appointment of a Chairperson and an Alternate Chairperson of the Appeals Committee to take effect immediately.
