Summary of Bankable Investment Project Profile – Volume II of V

Food Security Scheme (Wheat, Dates & Olives, Seed Production)

Estimated Cost: US\$1,031 m

Project Duration: 5 years

Project Objective: to improve national food security by increasing production of seeds, wheat, olives and dates.

Project Components and Main Activities:

- *Increased wheat production based on rehabilitation and expansion of cropped areas;*
- *Increased olive production and processing;*
- *Increased date palm production, preparation and storage*
- *Increased seed production for cereals, vegetables and forage crops*

Benefits. Improved food security based on increased production of seeds for cereals, vegetables and forage crops, as well as additional production of wheat, olives and dates.

Beneficiaries. Farmers and rural farm communities, as well as the population of Libya as a whole. These projects support Priority 4 of the NMTIP identified above and correspond to CAADP Pillar 3.
