


Level of Protection of the Right to Adequate Food, based on Provisions from the Text of National Constitutions



- (1) No apparent protection in the text of the constitution
- (2) Constitutions containing explicit provisions relating to the right to food
- (3) Constitutions protecting the right to food implicitly, through broader provisions dealing with the right to adequate standard of living, as well as through provisions on either social security or worker's rights – or both cumulatively
- (4) Constitutions protecting either the right to adequate standard of living, or social security and worker's rights
- (5) Constitutions protecting only the right to social security or the right to minimum wage
- (6) Constitutions containing other less important provisions, such as protection of the rights of the child, or promotion of agriculture, food safety etc.
