## Agenda Item 9: CX/CF 22/15/9

In the case of "MAXIMUM LEVELS FOR TOTAL AFLATOXINS IN CERTAIN CEREALS AND CEREAL-BASED PRODUCTS INCLUDING FOODS FOR INFANTS AND YOUNG CHILDREN AND ASSOCIATED SAMPLING PLANS - CX/CF 22/15/9", Iran opposes the proposed maximum levels for total aflatoxins (10  $\mu$ g/kg) for infants and young children, because it is directly related to the health of children, and If 1  $\mu$ g/kg of aflatoxins for cereal-based foods for infants and young children was not considered viable, so 5  $\mu$ g/kg or lower than that can be used instead.
