REQUEST FOR COMMENTS

- Codex members and observers are invited to submit comments on the proposed draft MLs for cadmium in chocolates and cocoa-derived products which is uploaded to the Codex Online Commenting System (OCS): <u>https://ocs.codexalimentarius.org/</u>, as per the guidance below.
- 3. In submitting comments, Codex members and observers are invited to take into account the conclusions presented in paragraphs 4-9 of CX/CF 20/14/6, the data analysis presented in Appendix II of the said working document and the background information presented in CL 2019/81-CF.
- 4. In addition, when considering the proposed MLs, the following should also be considered: the proportionality approach when setting MLs for the different categories, the MLs previously adopted at CAC41 (2018) and the discussion held on the proposed ML for chocolates containing or declaring <30% total cocoa solids on a dry matter basis at CCCF13 and CAC42 in 2019 (for consideration under Agenda Item 5).
