Context of the side event

The new FAO/WHO Codex Trust Fund (CTF2) was officially launched on 27 June 2016 at the 39th Session of the Codex Alimentarius Commission. In the first round of applications for support from the new Codex Trust Fund in 2016, demand from eligible countries was very high with 38 applications making it through to the review stage by the Technical Review Group. Many of these applications were strong, but not robust enough to be considered for support by the Codex Trust Fund. Only four countries were successful in this first round as a result of having submitted very strong applications.

Many eligible countries need more information on the scope and focus of CTF2 and additional guidance on how to prepare and submit robust applications. Many other countries are interested in learning more about the new Codex Trust Fund and tools for assessing the status of Codex capacity in countries. Side events are being organized at all FAO/WHO Regional Coordinating Committees in 2016 and 2017 to respond to this interest..

Objectives of the side event

- Provide information on the scope, focus and activities of CTF2
- Assist countries in understanding and using the "Diagnostic Tool for Assessing Status of National Codex Programmes" (the Codex Diagnostic Tool)
- Provide guidance to countries on preparing and submitting robust applications.
