1. VENUE

The 51st Session of Codex Committee on Pesticide Residues will be held in Grand Ballroom, the third floor of the **Studio City Macau** (澳门新濠影汇), Estrada do Istmo, Cotai, Macao SAR, P.R. China (澳门路氹金光大道). The session will start at 9:30 on Monday, 8 April. The adoption of the report will be held from 9:30 to 12:00 on Saturday, 13 April.

2. REGISTRATION

2.1. Online-Registration

3. VISA REQUIREMENTS

Lists of countries with visa and entry permit (or "Visa-upon-arrival") exemption, as well as those without exemption, can be found on the website of the Public Security Police Force of Macao SAR.

6. RESERVATION OF MEETING ROOM

By Studio City Macau Shuttle Buses or by Taxi

10.1. By Studio City Macau Shuttle Buses

Studio City Macau provides free shuttle bus service from different transport hubs, details as follows:

➤ **Macao International Airport**

Studio City Macau Shuttle Buses depart every 10 to 25 minutes from Macao International Airport, from 10:00 to 21:35. Walk toward the north exit of the airport and walk out into the parking lot.

➤ **Macao Ferry Terminal**

Studio City Macau Shuttle Buses depart every 6 to 25 minutes from Macao Ferry Terminal. Schedule of shuttle buses as follows:

09:00 - 10:00 / 11 - 25 mins

10:00 - 21:00 / 6 - 16 mins

21:00 - 24:00 / 12 - 16 mins

➤ **Taipa Ferry Terminal**

Studio City Macau Shuttle Buses depart every 7 to 30 minutes from Taipa Ferry Terminal, from 08:45 to 24:25. Schedule of shuttle buses as follows:

09:00 - 12:00 / 10-13 mins

12:00 - 20:00 / 7 - 10 mins

20:00 - 23:00 / 9 - 20 mins

After 23:00 / 20 - 30 mins

➤ **Gongbei-Macao Border Gate**

Studio City Macau Shuttle Buses depart every 5 to 15 minutes from Gongbei-Macao Border Gate, from 09:00 to 24:00. Schedule of shuttle buses as follows:

09:00 - 10:00 / 5 - 13 mins

10:00 - 21:00 / 5 - 10 mins

After 21:00 / 15 mins

11. GETTING TO MACAO

From Hong Kong International Airport or from Shenzhen Airport

11.1. From Hong Kong International Airport to Macao SAR

Option 1:

An airport route for transferring participants to Macao is provided from Hong Kong International Airport's SkyPier to Macao Peninsula and Taipa island of Macao). At Arrivals Level of Terminal 1, transferring participants must purchase the tickets present baggage tag receipts at the Ferries to Mainland/ Macao Ticketing Counter at Transfer E2. No immigration and baggage claim procedures required. Sailing time is about 70 minutes. Fare is 270 Hong Kong dollars (HK\$). This service is provided by two ferry operators.

Option 2:

If the sailing schedule of Hong Kong International Airport's SkyPier Transfer Ferry Service cannot meet your schedule, you can take a ferry from the Hong Kong-Macao Ferry Terminal in Shun Tak Centre. It is located above the Sheung Wan Mass Transit Railway (MTR) station. Ferries depart regularly to Macao Peninsula and Taipa from there, provided by two operators. Sailing time is about 55 minutes. Fares range from HK\$171 to HK\$211.

There are two main options of transportation between Hong Kong International Airport and Shun Tak Centre:

➤ **By The Airport Express**

The Airport Express takes participants from the airport to Central MTR Station in just 24 minutes. It is the fastest link to the city. The Airport Express Customer Service is immediately after Customs. Trains depart at about 10-minute intervals from 05:54 to 00:48 daily. Fare is about HK\$115.



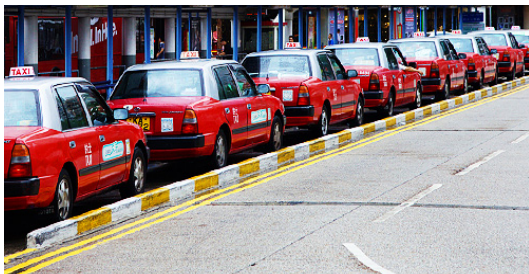
Taxi and MTR services are available from Central MTR Station to Sheung Wan MTR station. Taxi fare is around HK\$30 and MTR fare is around HK\$5. The journey takes around 7 minutes.

➤ **By Taxi**

Take a Red Taxi from Hong Kong International Airport to the Hong Kong-Macao Ferry Terminal. Fare is about HK\$300 and takes 30 minutes.



Option 3:

The Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge (HZMB) is 55-km long. It is the longest bridge-and-tunnel sea crossing in the world. It offers a 24-hour service cross-boundary Public Transport Services from Hong Kong to Macao Peninsula and it is very close to the Hong Kong International Airport. Travel time crossing the bridge from Hong Kong to Macao is about 40 minutes, with peak period headway at 5 minutes, non-peak period headway at 10-15 minutes and overnight period headway at 15-30 minutes. Bus tickets cost start at HK\$65. Shuttle bus ticket counters and ticket vending machines are available at the restricted area of the departure hall to facilitate passengers to purchase shuttle bus tickets. Passengers may also purchase the tickets online in advance.

➤ **From the Hong Kong International Airport to the HZMB Border Post:**

11.2. From Shenzhen Airport to Macao Outer Harbour

Regular ferry services are available from Shenzhen Airport to Macao Ferry Terminal at 9:00, 12:00, 15:00 and 16:30 (four daily connections only). Sailing time is approximately 60 minutes. Fare is approximately \$245 Patacas (MOP).

16.ELECTRICITY

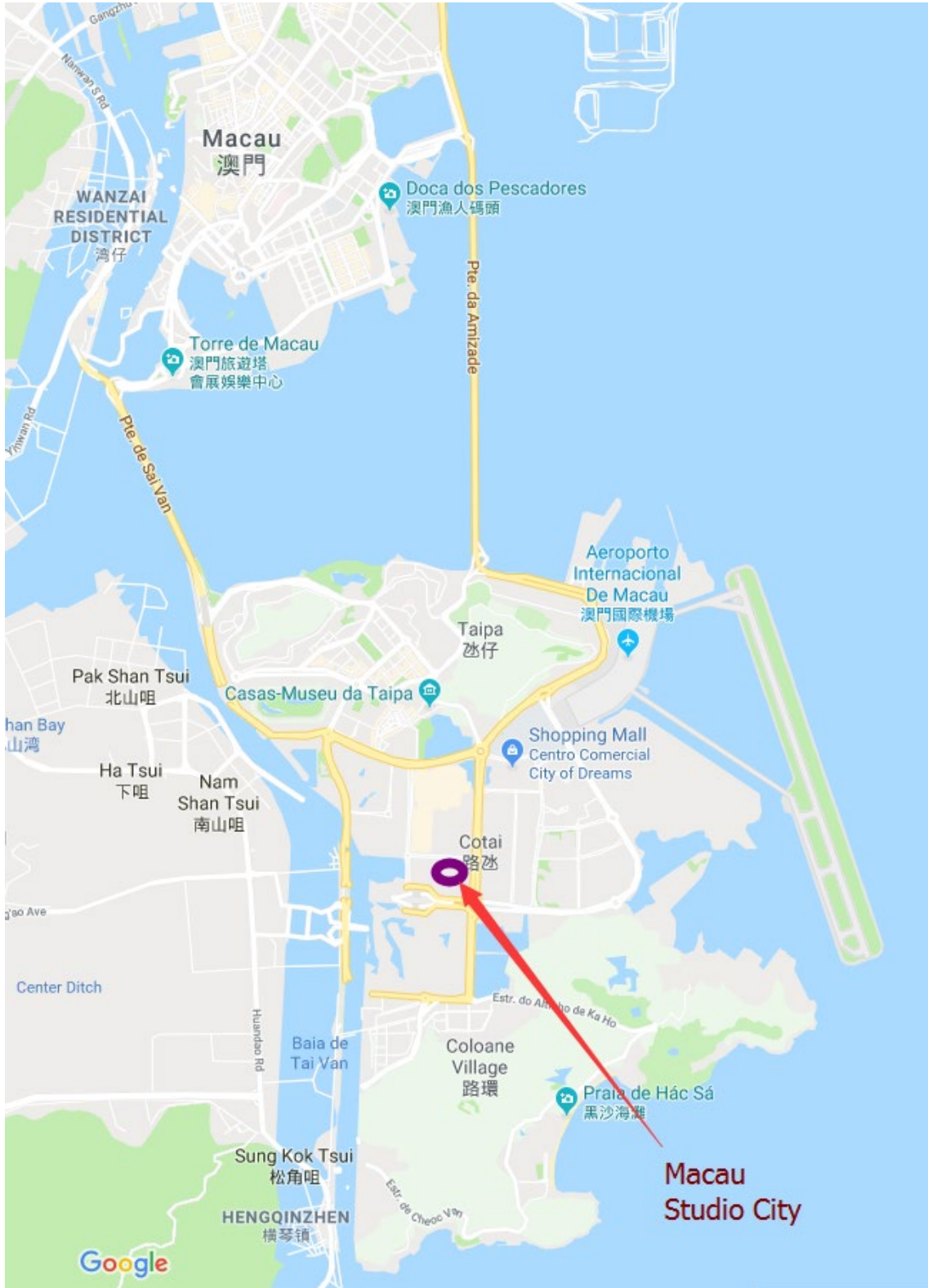
Electricity in Macao SAR is at 230V, 50Hz.

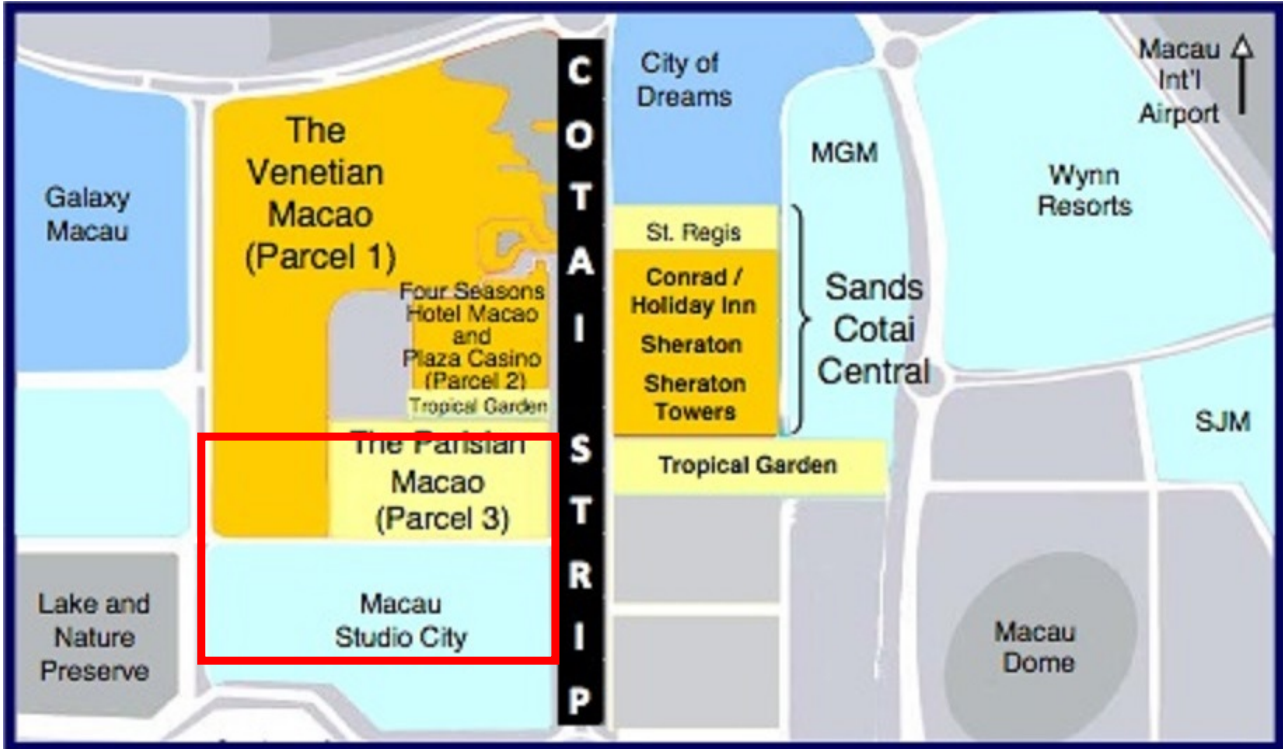
The power plugs used are of the three-pin square-shaped.

Since Macao was founded in the mid-16th century, it had been an entrepot of China's foreign trade over the centuries and a stepping stone of Western Catholicism to set foot in China. Being steeped in history and cultural diversity, the city is as vibrant as ever with its ceaseless mingling and interaction between Oriental and Occidental cultures. On 15 July, 2005, the Historical Centre of Macao that revolves around the city's old town area was inscribed into the World Heritage List to mark Macao's historical and cultural importance. By today, it boasts a multitude of attractions, be it the past or present (Local attraction list in **Annex 8**).
