



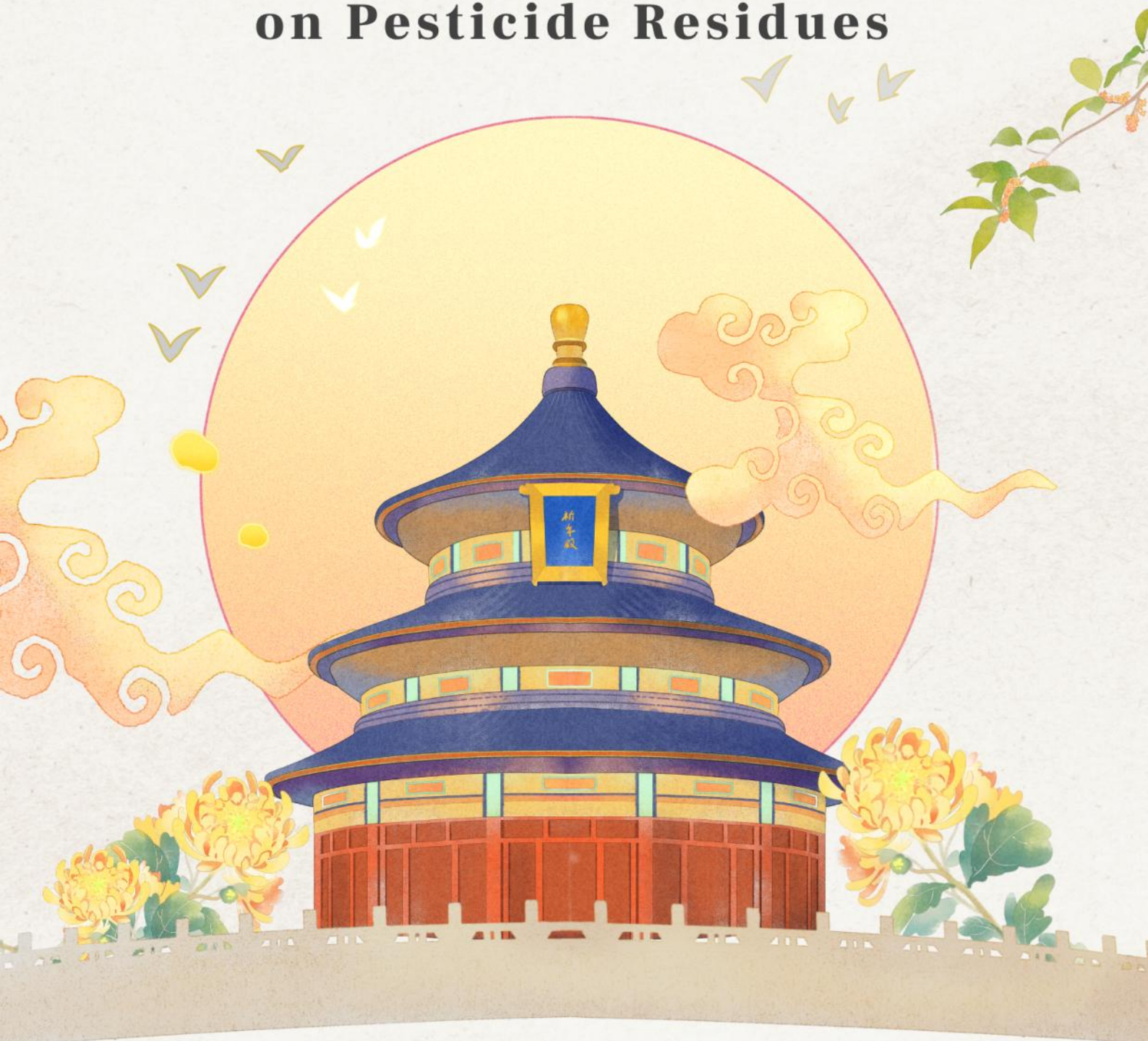

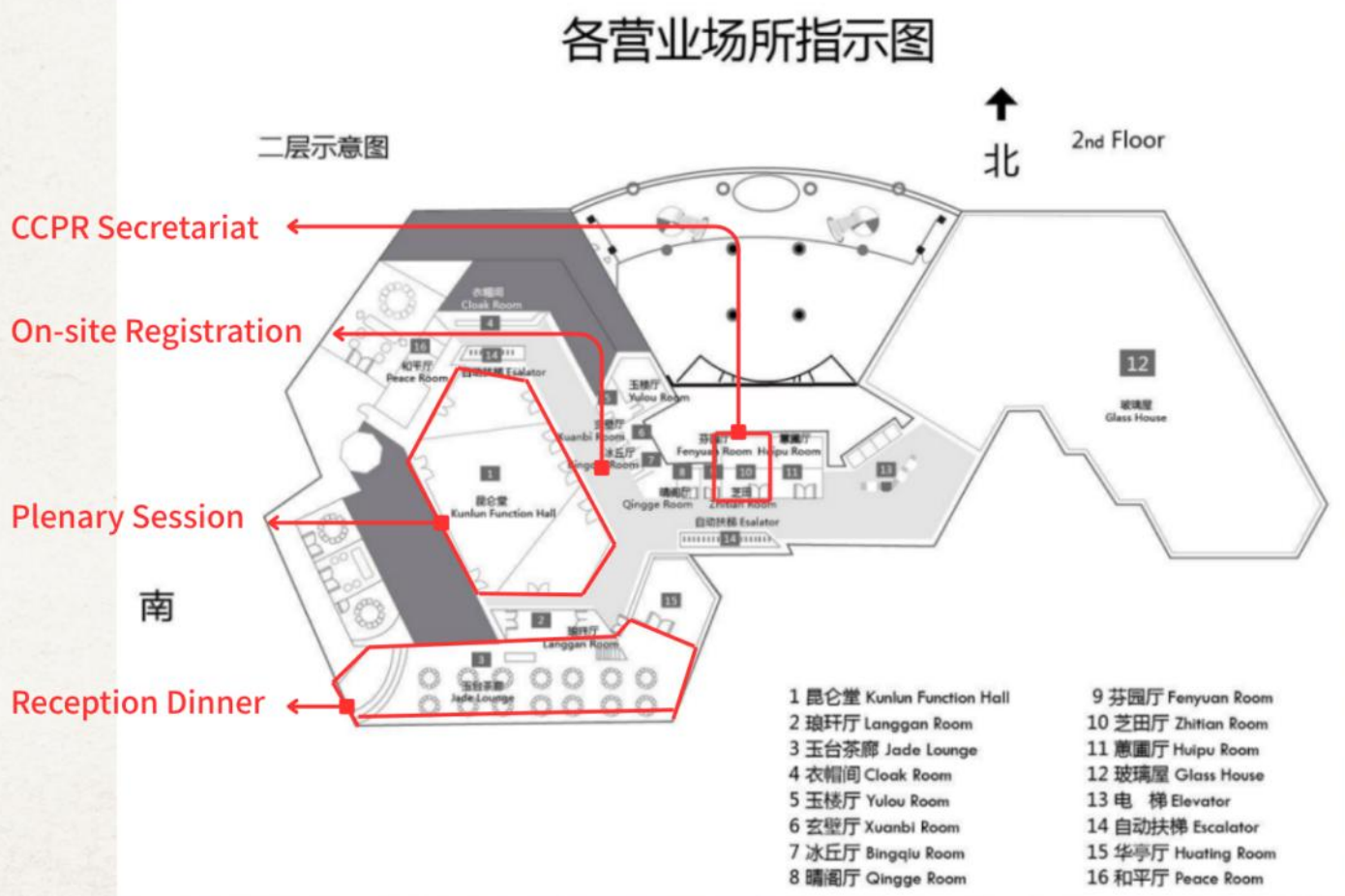

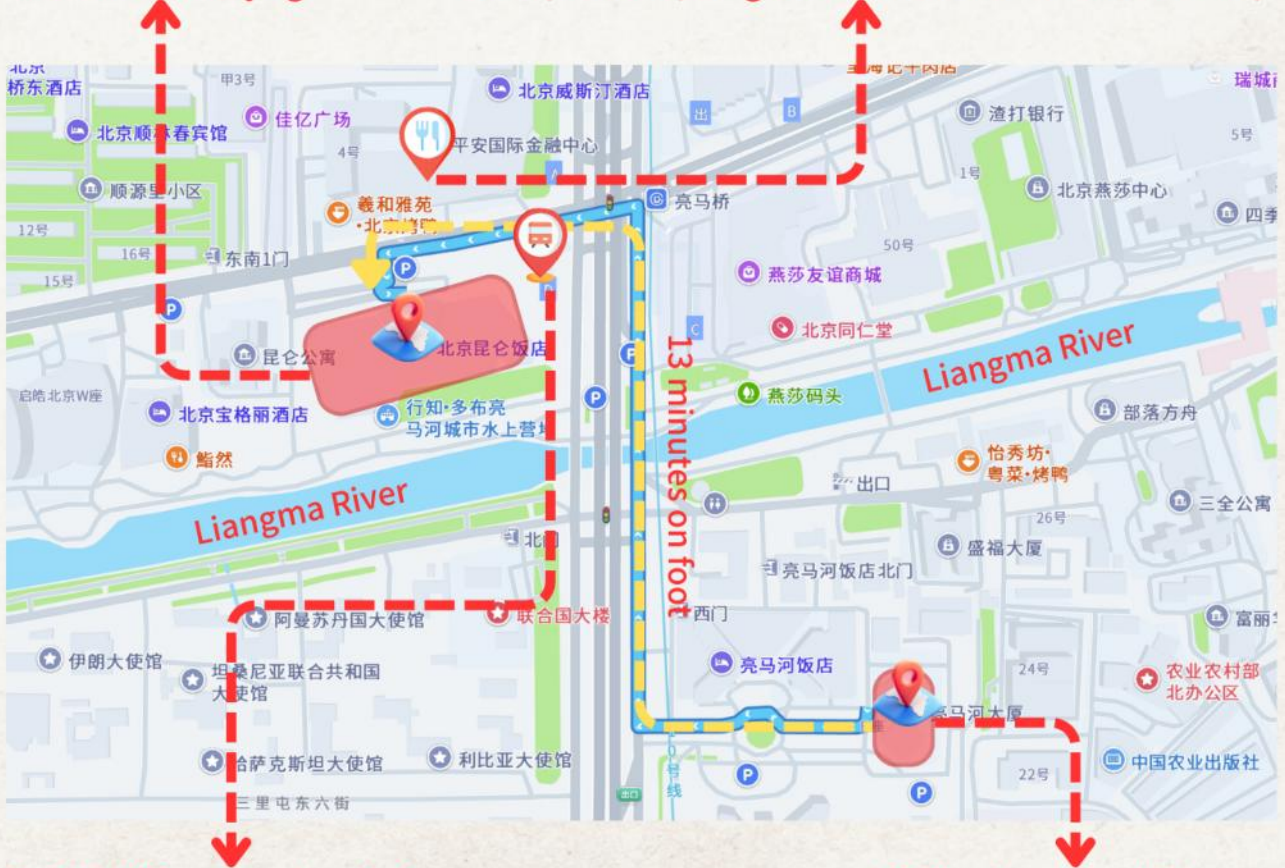

HOTEL LOCATION & AREA MAP

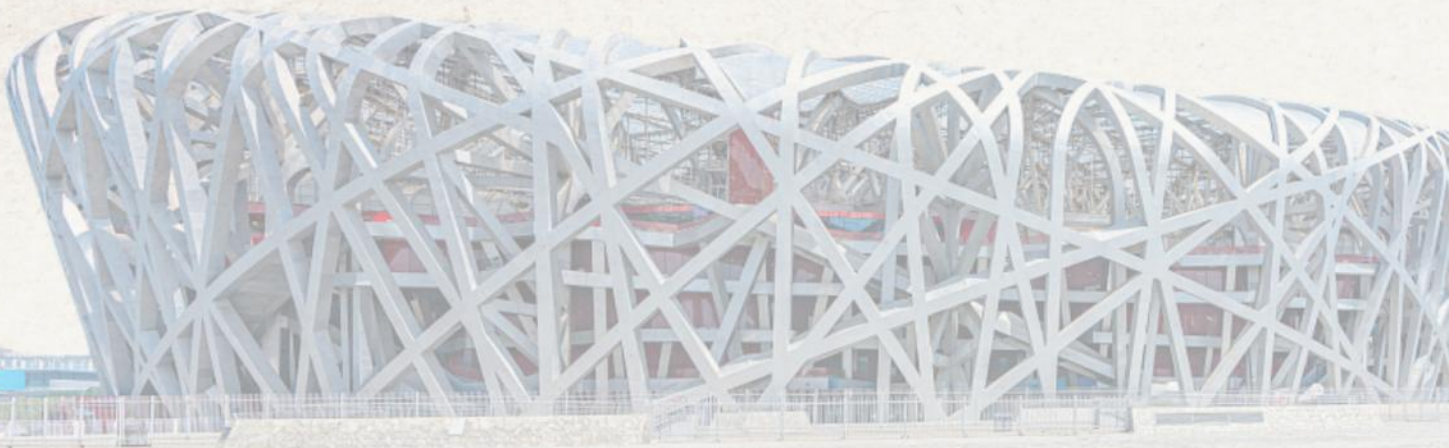

TRANSPORTATION

The Kunlun Beijing is located 24 km South-West to Beijing Capital International Airport (PEK) and 55 km North to Beijing Daxing International Airport (PKX). Participants should make their own transport arrangements from the airport to the hotel.

By taxi

Taxis in Beijing are required by law to operate by a meter system that provides a receipt. The average price from PEK/PKX to The Kunlun Beijing is about 100/200 RMB depending on traffic conditions. Please print the following card with the detail information of the hotel and show it to the driver.

By airport express and subway

Passengers from PEK can take the Capital Airport Express to Sanyuanqiao station, then transfer to the Subway Line 10 and get off at Liangmaqiao station. Passengers from PKX can take the Daxing Airport Express to Caoqiao station, then transfer to the Subway Line 10 and get off at Liangmaqiao station. It takes 2 minutes walking from Exit D of Liangmaqiao station to The Kunlun Beijing.



VISA & ENTRY

Delegates should check with their local Chinese Embassy or Consulate as to whether they need a visa to enter China. Visa application forms, as well as the information requirement, are available from the following website

The delegates from the countries that haven't established diplomatic relationship with China, could acquire the visa from the adjacent country which has established diplomatic relationship with China.

If assistance is needed to facilitate the issuance of a visa, the Authorized Visa Invitation Letter can be provided to support visa applications. RECOMMENDED CULTURAL SITES

The Palace Museum

Established on October 10, 1925, the Palace Museum is located in the Forbidden City of Beijing. Built on the basis of the imperial palaces and collections of the Ming and Qing dynasties, it is a comprehensive museum and the largest ancient culture and art museum in China. Its cultural relics are mainly inherited from the old collections of the Qing royal court. It is one of the first National Patriotic Education Demonstration Bases and also one of the world's three major imperial palaces.

The Palace Museum is among the first batch of National Key Cultural Relics Protection Units and the first batch of national 5A-level tourist attractions. It was included in the World Heritage List in 1987.

It is closed every Monday except legal holidays. Tickets are not sold on the day of visit. Advance booking is available from 20:00, 7 days in advance.

the Temple of Heaven

Built in 1420 (the 18th year of the Ming-dynasty Yongle Emperor' s reign), the Temple of Heaven is located outside and to the east of the Zhengyang Gate, and its grounds cover 2.73 square kilometers. It is where the imperial families of the Ming and Qing dynasties held ceremonies to offer sacrifices to Heaven and pray for good harvests. It was originally called the Temple of Heaven and Earth, and with later expansion and renovation, it is now the world' s largest and best-preserved ancient imperial complex dedicated to the worship of Heaven.

The Temple of Heaven became a park opened to the public in 1918. In 1961, the State Council designated it as one of the first national cultural heritage sites. In 1998, it was inscribed onto UNESCO' s World Heritage List. In 2007, it was made a National 5A-level Tourist Attraction. In 2024, the Beijing Central Axis, which consists of the Temple of Heaven and 14 other elements, was given UNESCO World Heritage status.

It is closed every Monday except legal holidays.

Badaling Great Wall

Located 60 kilometers northwest of central Beijing in Yanqing District, the Badaling Great Wall consists of strategic passes and attached ramparts. Perched on the commanding northern passage to the capital, it enjoys a dangerous terrain and is famed as the "Northern Gateway to the Capital", a vital stronghold guarding Beijing.

The open section extends 3,741 meters with 21 towers and platforms. It was designated a National Key Cultural Relic Protection Unit in 1961, a National Key Scenic Area in 1987, and inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage List in 1987. It received the World Cultural Heritage Certificate in 1991, earned a Guinness World Record in 2002, and was named one of China's first 5A-level Tourist Attractions as well as the top of the New Seven Wonders of the World in 2007.

Today, Badaling serves as a prestigious platform for international cultural exchanges, hosting over 30 cultural and sports events annually. It is a world-renowned scenic spot and an important state guest reception site.

It is closed every Monday except legal holidays.

798 ArtDist

798 Art District, also named Dashanzi Art District, is located in Dashanzi, Jiuxianqiao Subdistrict, Chaoyang District, serving as a famous art landmark of Beijing.

It was formerly the North China Joint Radio Equipment Factory (No.718 Joint Factory), aided by the Soviet Union and designed by East Germany. In 2002, the first art institution settled here, followed by the entry of Tokyo Gallery and local art spaces.

Rated by *Time* as one of the world's top 22 urban art centers in 2003, it has become a cultural symbol of China's reform and opening-up. Designated as one of Beijing's first cultural and creative industry clusters in 2005, the district now houses over 400 galleries, art centers and design institutions, including UCCA Center for Contemporary Art and Bahrain Cultural Center.

It hosted the inaugural Beijing 798 Creative Culture Festival in 2006, and was added to the Beijing Excellent Modern and Contemporary Architecture Protection List in 2007. Pace Gallery from New York opened its only Asian branch here in 2008. Later in December 2020, it was listed as a national cultural industry demonstration park, and officially awarded the title of National Industrial Tourism Demonstration Base in October 2023.
