# FAO/WHO Side Event on the Codex Trust Fund 14<sup>th</sup> Session of the FAO/WHO Regional Coordinating Committee for North America and the South West Pacific (CCNASWP)

## The new FAO/WHO Codex Trust Fund

#### Information session on the new Codex Trust Fund (CTF2)

Tuesday, 20 September 2016, 2 hour session (evening)

#### Context of the side event

The new FAO/WHO Codex Trust Fund (CTF2) was officially launched on 27 June 2016 at the 39<sup>th</sup> Session of the Codex Alimentarius Commission. Since then, information has been disseminated on CTF2 through the CTF Secretariat and FAO and WHO channels, and during the 39<sup>th</sup> Session of the Codex Alimentarius Commission (CAC). This included information on the focus and scope of the CTF, the type of support available, eligible countries, governance and management of the CTF. An important milestone has been the completion of the first application round (in June 2016) for support from the new Codex Trust Fund. Demand from eligible countries was very high. A total of 38 applications made it through to the review stage by the Technical Review Group. Of these, four applications were successful in receiving support in 2016, as they met the assessment criteria.

The 39th Session of the CAC provided an important opportunity to deepen everyone's understanding of the Codex Trust Fund, and gain feedback from Codex members. Many eligible countries need more information on the scope and focus of CTF2 and additional guidance on how to prepare and submit robust applications. Side events are being organized at all FAO/WHO Regional Coordinating Committees in 2016 and 2017 to continue information dissemination efforts and dialogue on CTF.

Please note, this side event during the session of CCNASWP, will be complemented by a more handson workshop on preparing robust applications, on the 23 September 2016. Participants are requested to attend this Tuesday evening CTF2 side-event as a pre-requisite session to attendance on Friday.
