I hope this letter finds you well. The next CCCF is getting close, being scheduled for 9-13 May with the adoption of the report on 24 May. I had hoped I would be able to welcome you to the Netherlands in real life – to have good discussions on the relevant issues concerning contaminants in foods, but I was also looking forward to getting to know you personally. However, this was not meant to be, and we will have our meeting in a virtual setting for the second time. I hope we can use our experience from last year to have a good meeting again.

I would like to highlight that, in the week before the plenary meeting, we have three virtual meetings planned from 13.00-16.00 CET:

- 3 May: in-session working groups of Review of Codex Standards for Contaminants, Follow-up Work to the Outcomes of JECFA Evaluations and FAO/WHO Expert Consultations and Priority List of Contaminants for Evaluation by JECFA (agenda items 18, 19 and 20);
- 5 May: virtual side event on Review of methods of analysis for contaminants (agenda item 16);
- 6 May: virtual side event on Guidance for data analysis for development of MLs and improved data collection (agenda item 15), followed at 15.00-15.30 CET by an introduction to CCCF meetings for first-time delegates.
