## Side event on the Tripartite Support for Tackling Antimicrobial Resistance

## Background

The Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO), together with the World Health Organization (WHO) and the World Organization for Animal Health (OIE) - collectively known as the Tripartite - work together to support countries to achieve their antimicrobial resistance National Action Plan (NAP) goals, including the application of Codex relevant standards and related texts.

Through the presentation of examples of past activities of the three organizations in various sectors and a question and answer period, this side event will provide information to delegates about:

- opportunities to engage further to tackle AMR
- FAO, WHO and OIE initiatives that could facilitate discussions at TFAMR07 on the guidelines for monitoring and surveillance of foodborne AMR and the code of practice to minimize and contain foodborne AMR and support their implementation after the work of the Task Force.

## Program schedule

The side event will include an introduction to the topic, presentations from FAO, WHO and OIE, a question and answer session, and a summary of the main issues and findings .

The side event will build on the information provided under Agenda Item 3 and will last for a maximum of two hours.
