PROPOSED DRAFT AMENDMENT TO THE STANDARD FOR QUICK FROZEN LOBSTERS GOVERNMENT COMMENTS AT STEP 3

CANADA

General Comments:

- 1. Canada would like to acknowledge the good work of Chile in amending the Standard for Quick Frozen Lobsters.
- 2. Canada did not see a clear need in some sections for repeating "squat lobster" in connection with "lobsters" and is of the view that the only sections that require revision are: Scope, Product Description (2.1), Labelling (6.1 Name of the Food) and Sampling, Examination and Analysis (7.1(i) Sampling). In all other occurrences in the Standard, Canada proposes that "squat lobster" should be referred to as "lobsters," as stipulated in footnote # 2.

Specific Comments:

SECTION 2 - DESCRIPTION

Section 2.1

<u>3.</u> Canada recalled that the Committee discussed and agreed that the Standard for Quick Frozen Lobsters should be amended to include the species, <u>Pleuroncodes monodon</u> and <u>Cervimundia johni</u>. The text in the revised standard, ". . . . genus <u>Pleuroncodes</u> and <u>Cervimundia</u>" differs from decision of the Committee. To avoid confusion, the Committee should clarify the scope of inclusion.
