WORK OF THE CODEX COMMITTEE ON RESIDUES OF VETERINARY DRUGS IN FOODS (CCRVDF)

1. The 49th Session of the Codex Alimentarius Commission (CAC49) is invited to adopt the standards and related texts submitted for adoption by CCRVDF28 as listed in **Part 1** of this document.
