### Agenda Item 3

CX/PR 25/56/2

#### Matters referred to CCPR by CAC and/or other subsidiary bodies

Nigeria would like to thank the Codex Secretariat in preparing this document.

Nigeria supports the proposed amendment as set out in APPENDIX I “Original language only Part 1: Comments in reply to CL 2024/27-GP relevant to Section 4.8 “Risk analysis principles applied by the Codex Committee on Pesticide Residues” as contained in CX/CAC 24/47/2 Add.1 (For consideration by CCPR) Comments by Member States of the European Union (MSEU) and the United States of America (USA)”

However, Nigeria proposed that Paragraph 246.b should be changed to read “JMPR report should be available electronically three (3) months prior to CCPR”

**Rationale:** To enable Codex member countries to review the document prior to attending the CCPR.

#### CXLs for milk and milk fat

Nigeria would like to thank the Codex Secretariat in preparing this document.

Nigeria supports the decision taken by CCPR40 to insert the note “for monitoring and regulatory purposes, whole milk is to be analysed, and the result compared to the MRL for whole milk” to the CXLs for milk in the Codex database in all cases where CXLs are established for fat-soluble pesticides in both milk and milk fat; and also request JMPR to insert this note alongside the MRL for whole milk in all cases where MRLs were established for both milk fat and whole milk for fat-soluble pesticides.

### Agenda Item 7

CX/PR 25/56/8

#### Guidelines for monitoring the stability and purity of reference materials and related stock solutions of pesticides during prolonged storage (at Step 7)

Nigeria appreciates the work done by the Electronic Working Group chaired by India and co-chaired by Canada, Iran (Islamic Republic of) and Singapore.

Nigeria supports the proposed guidelines as set out in Appendix 1 and its advancement to Step 8 for final adoption by CAC48 (November 2025).

**RATIONALE:** This document has made provision to support verification of stability of reference materials of pesticides during prolong storage.
