Comments submitted by Indonesia

The Government of Indonesia would like to congratulate the 56th Session of the Codex Committee on Pesticide Residues for its work and take this opportunity to submit the following comments.

Agenda Item 6.1

CX/PR 25/56/5

MRLs for pesticides in food and feed (at Steps 7 and 4)

1. Revision of commodity codes in Class B

Indonesia agrees to the revised commodity codes for Class B regarding food commodities of animal origin such as “meat” into “group of muscle”, “eggs” into “group of eggs”, etc.

2. Florpyrauxifen-benzyl (341)

Indonesia supports the advancement of the MRLs for the listed crops to Step 5/8.

CXLs for milk and milk fat

Indonesia agrees to include the said statement in the Codex Database for milk CXLs in all cases where CXLs are established for fat-soluble pesticides in both milk and milk fat.

Indonesia agrees to temporarily suspend the National Registration Database (NRD).

B. FINALISING THE 2026 PROPOSED SCHEDULE

Indonesia supports the proposed schedule 2026-new compounds for Fenmezoditiaz and Metyltetraprole;

Indonesia also supports the proposed 2026-new uses and other evaluations for Trifloxystrobin, Florylpicoxamid, Cyclobutrifluram, Fluoxapiprolin, Isotianil, Bixafen, and Flutriafol.

Indonesia supports the proposed schedule for the 2026 periodic review for Indoxacarb and Maleic hydrazide in apple, meat, garlic, and bulb onion.

Indonesia supports the proposed schedule of 2027-new compounds and 2027-new uses and other evaluations for Tetflupyrolimet, Fluindapyr, Benzovindiflupyr and Chlorantraniliprole.
