Agenda item 4: Proposed Draft regional standard for the dried meat

General Comment

Appendix I:

Position: Burundi reviewed the Draft regional standard for dried meat, and supports the advancement of the draft in the step process to step 8 for adoption.

Rationale: The draft has considered most of comments received and can proceed to the next step for adoption with consideration of following comments.

Scope:

Position: Burundi suggests deleting "Marketing"

Rationale: Burundi culture does not allow some animal meats to be marketing

Clause 3.2.2 Quality Factors, Table 1 Quality requirements

Position: Burundi support Moisture content (% m/m) Min 10, but consider Max of 35% as high,

Burundi support for Ash Content (%) Max of 8

Rationale: References consulted recommended not to going over 10

Clause 8.2

Position: Burundi proposes to delete this sub clause.

Rationale: Not appropriate to this standard as the scope of the standard covers dried meat not animals.

Clause 9.2 Sampling

Position: Burundi support to maintain this clause.

Rationale: Sampling to be carried according to the existing codex standard
